### **Mas Tec College League General Information (Summer 2018)**

1. League runs from June 11<sup>th</sup> – July 25th (2018)
2. Games will be played on Mondays & Wednesdays
3. Game Times: 6:00 / 7:00 / (4 games per night)
4. No Games on 4<sup>th</sup> of July Week (July 2<sup>nd</sup> or July 4<sup>th</sup>)
5. Games will be 40 Minutes (20 minute halves)
6. Clock stops on timeouts, w/ 1 minute left in first half, & w/ 2 minutes left in second half
7. Each coach has 3 Full Timeouts (45 Seconds)
8. Overtime will be 2 minutes stopping time (1 timeout)
9. Coaches Must Wear CBF / MasTec Polos or T-Shirts
10. Players will wear CBF / MasTec Uniforms
  - Receive your uniform prior to game
11. Uniforms will be washed by CBF Sports Management
12. Workers: 2 referees, clock keeper, & stat keeper (4 workers)
13. Stats will be updated online daily
14. Referees, Clock Keeper, & Stat Keeper should arrive 15 minutes prior to game time

16. Excessive Unexcused Absences or Tardies may result in dismissal from the league
17. Professionalism & Respect must be maintained (for referees, coaches, & other players)

## MasTec College League Rules (2018)

- I. **Registration:** All Players must print a registration form online at [www.CBFCamps.com](http://www.CBFCamps.com) or Coach Juan will email you one. Once CBF Sports Management receives the required documents (registration form, waiver form, & a headshot picture), the player will be eligible for participation in the league.
- II. **Game Time:** All Games will consist of two twenty minute halves (40 minutes total)
  - Clock stops during timeouts
  - Clock stops under one minute in first half
  - Clock stops under two minutes in second half
- III. **Timeouts** will be awarded as follows:
  - Three Full Timeouts (45 Seconds)
  - One Full Timeout Per Overtime
- IV. **Technical Fouls / Foul-Out:** Two direct technical fouls during a game on a player, coach, or team representative will result in their disqualification for the game. Fighting and gross unsportsmanlike behavior can result in dismissal from the league (at the discretion of CBF Sports Management, Inc.). Players will foul out with 6 fouls.
- V. **Overtime:** Will consist of 2 minutes (stopping time / 1 timeout per team)
- VI. **Bonus Situations:** Bonus at 8 fouls & double bonus at 10 fouls (each half)
- VII. **Basketballs:** CBF Sports Management will provide basketballs for warm-ups as well as the Game Ball.
- VIII. **Uniforms:** Uniforms will be available for pickup thirty minutes prior to game time. Coaches will collect uniforms after games & CBF Sports Management, Inc. will be responsible for washing them. Players are not to keep or take home the uniforms. They must be collected after each game. Players can keep their uniform after their last game of the league is played.
- IX. **Absences / Tardiness:** If a player or coach is planning to be Absent or Tardy to their game they must call, text or email Juan Hernandez Cell: 786-393-0452 or Email: [CoachJuan@cbfsportsmgnt.com](mailto:CoachJuan@cbfsportsmgnt.com). Two unexcused absences or four unexcused tardies will result in suspension or disqualification from the league (at the discretion of CBF Sports Management, Inc.)
- X. **Rosters:** Each team will have a Head Coach, Assistant Coach, & a 10-12 player roster. No players can participate without submitting the required documents.
- XI. **Roster Changes:** CBF Sports Management, Inc. is solely responsible for putting teams together. Players must be on the official roster in order to participate.
- XII. **League Games / Playoffs:** Each team will play eight regular season games & have an opportunity to participate in the playoffs.
