

WOODLANDS LEISURE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Leisure Club will be owned and operated by D Wright, S Wright & W Wright and to be managed and administered by such persons, as they shall nominate.
2. Memberships will be granted at the discretion of the management and members will be required to show their membership cards on each visit to the club.
3. Membership will not be transferable and the management reserve the right to refuse applications and renewals of membership and terminate any membership without notice, and without giving any reason for doing so. In the case of membership being terminated it shall be at the sole discretion of the management as to whether any of the membership fee is refundable.
4. Persons under 16 years of age are permitted to use the Swimming Pool facilities only when accompanied by an adult of 18 years and over who shall be responsible for that person's conduct at all times. Any children under the age of 8 must have a responsible adult, age 18 years or over, in the water with them at all times. Persons under 14 years old may not use the gym. Persons aged 14 and 15 years old before using the gym must complete all gym inductions with a gym instructor and a responsible adult must be present during the first session.
Any person/s under supervision of carer/s must be within close contact with their carer at all times according with their risk assessment and policy.
5. The Club accepts no liability for any illness or injury resulting from the use of any of the Club facilities however that may have been caused. The Club accepts no liability for any illness or injury resulting from over-exertion or the provocation of any medical condition caused by the use of the Club facilities. All persons use the facilities on the expressed understanding that it is at their own risk and members and guests are strongly advised to seek medical advice before they begin any exercise at the Club.
6. Members and guests are required to use the club facilities in a proper and reasonable manner.
7. Members and guests must be suitably attired while using the club facilities. Trainers shall be worn at all times when exercising. No jeans to be worn whilst using any of the gym equipment. All users are to wear suitable bathing attire whilst using any of the pool facilities, including the sauna and steam rooms. For hygiene reasons, it is requested that all members and guests shower before using the pool and sit on a towel when using the sauna.
8. In the interest of safety, running, diving and jumping are not allowed in the pool areas, or the use of snorkels, flippers and beach balls. Only safe jumping and diving during a swimming lesson under the guidance of a swimming teacher/coach is permitted. Smoking and glass bottles/objects are not allowed in the club, and members and guests should not use the facilities while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
9. No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to the property or valuables of any member or guest even those that may be left in the lockers provided.
10. The club reserves the right, at any time, to vary these rules, available facilities, entry fee or membership subscription or any of the charges for use of any or all the facilities.
11. The club may be closed for essential maintenance work, special functions or for any other reason as the management may feel necessary.
12. Members will further comply with any direction that the Leisure Club Staff may give to ensure the smooth operation of the Club, the use of the facilities and the convenience of all members.
13. The Manager, whose decision shall be final and binding on all members, shall determine any dispute or difference which may arise in regard to the interpretation of these rules.

Membership

15. All new members must complete a membership details form and shall be obliged to notify the Club immediately in writing of any change in the answers given. All personal data provided is covered by our privacy policy, see our website for details.
16. All memberships include swimming pool, gymnasium, sauna, steam room, spa bath and fitness assessment.
17. Entry allowed between opening hours, although during classes it is restricted use. No time limit on use of facilities, guidelines and advice available.
18. All memberships are non refundable. We reserve the right to deny or cancel membership where we feel necessary
19. Direct debit payments will be taken on the 1st day of each month. An initial payment of 1 month at direct debit rate is to be paid upon joining. Any adjustments will be made on 1st payment taken from bank (for example, if joined half way through a month the 1st payment by direct debit will, be half). You will receive confirmation of the amount in writing before the 1st payment is taken.
20. Direct debit memberships are for a minimum of 3 continuous months. After initial 3 months suspension of payments can be arranged by notifying the office. To cancel your membership you must notify our office and your bank. If cancelled within last 10 days of a month a payment will still be taken for the following month, unless cancelled with your bank.
21. Annual memberships run from date joined for 1 year. Payments to be made in cash, cheque or credit debit card. Suspended periods of absence for 1 month or more can be arranged by notifying our office.
