Reading - Secure decoding of unfamiliar words, read for a range of purposes, retell some stories orally, discuss words and phrases that capture the imagination, identify themes and conventions, retrieve and record information, make inferences and justify predictions, recognise a variety of forms of poetry, identify and summarise ideas

Writing - Correctly spell common homophones, increase regularity of handwriting, plan writing based on familiar forms, organise writing into paragraphs, use simple organisational devices, proof-read for spelling and punctuation errors, evaluate own and others' writing, read own writing aloud

Grammar - Use wider range of conjunctions, use perfect tense appropriately, select pronouns and nouns for clarity, use and punctuate direct speech, use commas after front adverbials

Speaking & Listening - Articulate and justify opinions, speak audibly in Standard English, gain, maintain and monitor interest of listeners
