





Grade Distribution




Age Distribution







Programs in September

Culture Awareness

We begin our Culture Exchange every year culture exchange sessions. This allows students from Nepal and the USA to meet the team members virtually and learn more about each country.

This month, the Program Manager met with the students of Churchill and talked about Nepal, the cultural exchange program, and more. Similarly, the team in Nepal physically met with the students in Nepal and conducted the cultural awareness program.

Katha Bunaun Session

We focus on enhancing students' self-expression, creativity, and articulation. For this, we conduct Katha Bunaun session, which allows students to explore their surroundings, take inspiration from it, and write their own stories from scratch. This month, we worked with our partner school and students that were previously a part of the cultural exchange in 2019.

Skill Enhancement

For students to properly communicate, comprehend, and articulate with their friends in letters and video calls, we conduct skill enhancement sessions to polish their reading, writing, speaking, listening, and critical skills. These sessions are intensive and month-long to allow students to build rapport with the facilitator and grow individually.







Way Forward in October

Katha Bunaun Session

We have planned one Katha Bunaun session every month, so we will also conduct one in October. This session will be themed around festivals since it is festive season in Nepal.

Socratic Seminar

We partner with schools and colleges for yearly programs. Within the partnership, we incorporate our programs, like Socratic Seminars, in the schools' calendars and yearly plans. We have sessions planned out in schools and colleges in September.

Culture Exchange Program

Students in the USA have already started writing their letters. The first set of letters will reach Nepal in October where students will get to read them as soon as they're back from their holiday.
