Parade Rules:

Accompanying walkers may distribute (not throw) items along the sides of the parade route

All parade entries must be family friendly and FUN – theme for 2022: Lucky to be in Mansfield
All entries must be decorated in accordance with the Parade Awards guidelines

Maximum height for float = 14 feet

Any guns or weapons used for props/decorations **MUST** be affixed to your parade float.
NO ammunition is permitted.

No alcohol on parade premises.

Flags displayed must be United States of America, State of Texas, Armed Forces, City of Mansfield or local school only.

If you have animals in the parade, you must clean up after them.

Recorded music is allowed with pre-approval of the parade committee.

ALL parade entries MUST have a representative at the MANDATORY Pre-Parade Orientation Meeting, 3 pm Sunday, March 13th at the Chris Burkett Center 620 S Wisteria St, Mansfield TX

Waivers for minor parade entrants must be submitted at or prior to the above meeting.

All participants or a group representative *must sign* the parade waiver. If any unapproved group or persons attempts to join an approved group in the parade, they will be told to leave the area.
