

BASIC DISASTER SAFETY



FOR AG BUSINESS OWNERS & WORKERS

This three-hour class is for Agriculture business owners, their workers who may be permitted to enter Mandatory Evac Zones to care for their property and animals during an ongoing disaster, and, other Ag industry workers who may be called upon by Incident Command to assist them.

Class covers basic safety and situational awareness in Wildland and WUI fire, flood/slide and earthquake incidents. Additional training is required for those interested in joining a Community Animal Response Team (such as Sonoma CART or Napa CART).

Enrollment is open to: Dept of Agriculture staff, UCCE/ANR staff, 4-H and FFA leaders, members of Farm Bureau, Farm Trails, CAFF, and other Ag organizations, Agricultural Facility Managers and workers, County Agency Staff, Teachers, or anyone interested in being safer during and after a disaster.

Class is taught by State of California Fire Training Instructors.
