2SC 'Family Members' desire to move *forward* in life.



What do we mean by this?

'Moving *forward* in life' means that we are not satisfied with where we are in life- mentally, physically, spiritually, and/or materially- and we intend to take any steps necessary for transformation.

- 2SC Family members recognize and choose positive transformation, and to be about this work in community with other 2SC Family Members, volunteer staff, and appropriate community partners.
- 2SC Family members understand and value interaction with God through pursuing a relationship with Jesus Christ. We understand that this relationship comes in various stages of commitment and results, but that this relationship is of deep importance to our journey of transformation.



There's room for YOU!

- Because of our commitment to the teachings of Jesus Christ, neighborhood, neighbors, fellow 2SC Family Members, and others in general are of great importance to us and worthy of our service to them.
- 2SC Family Members are committed to our 'place'- the 2nd Street Commons. We maintain it, protect it, and we keep it safe because it is a gift from God to us.
- 2SC Family Members choose to pursue change in the context of 'family'. We are working on our own plans and we are helping others in the 2SC family to pursue their plans.
- 2SC Family Members choose healthy lifestyles which include treatment of addictions, avoidance of drunkenness and illegal drug use, working on our physical, mental, and spiritual health, and living in simple, helpful ways.

2SC FAMILY MEMBER PROCESS

- Fill out Family Member Application/ set appoint to meet with KCS Exec. Director or KCS Chaplain
- Attend Orientation with KCS Executive Director or KCS Chaplain
 - Review 2SC Manual. Note and discuss any differences and/or problems with 2SC Guidelines and Procedures
 - Discuss 2SC operations and behavioral expectations
 - Have applicant sign 2SC Family Member Agreement
 - Take picture of applicant (for membership card)
 - Set appointment to develop 'life plan'
- Meet with assigned mentor to discuss and develop life plan
 - Health goals- addiction, mental, physical, and spiritual
 - Immediate needs- ID card, housing, clothing, etc.
 - Service to other goals- 2SC, neighborhood, family etc.
 - Evaluate finances/ Develop budget
 - Develop personal scheduling calendar
- Commitment to ongoing work
 - Continued meetings with mentor team
 - Follow through with community partners
 - Attendance of all meetings designated in your life plan
 - Service at 2SC and 2SC neighborhood (you will be assigned regular chores at 2SC and surrounding neighborhood.
