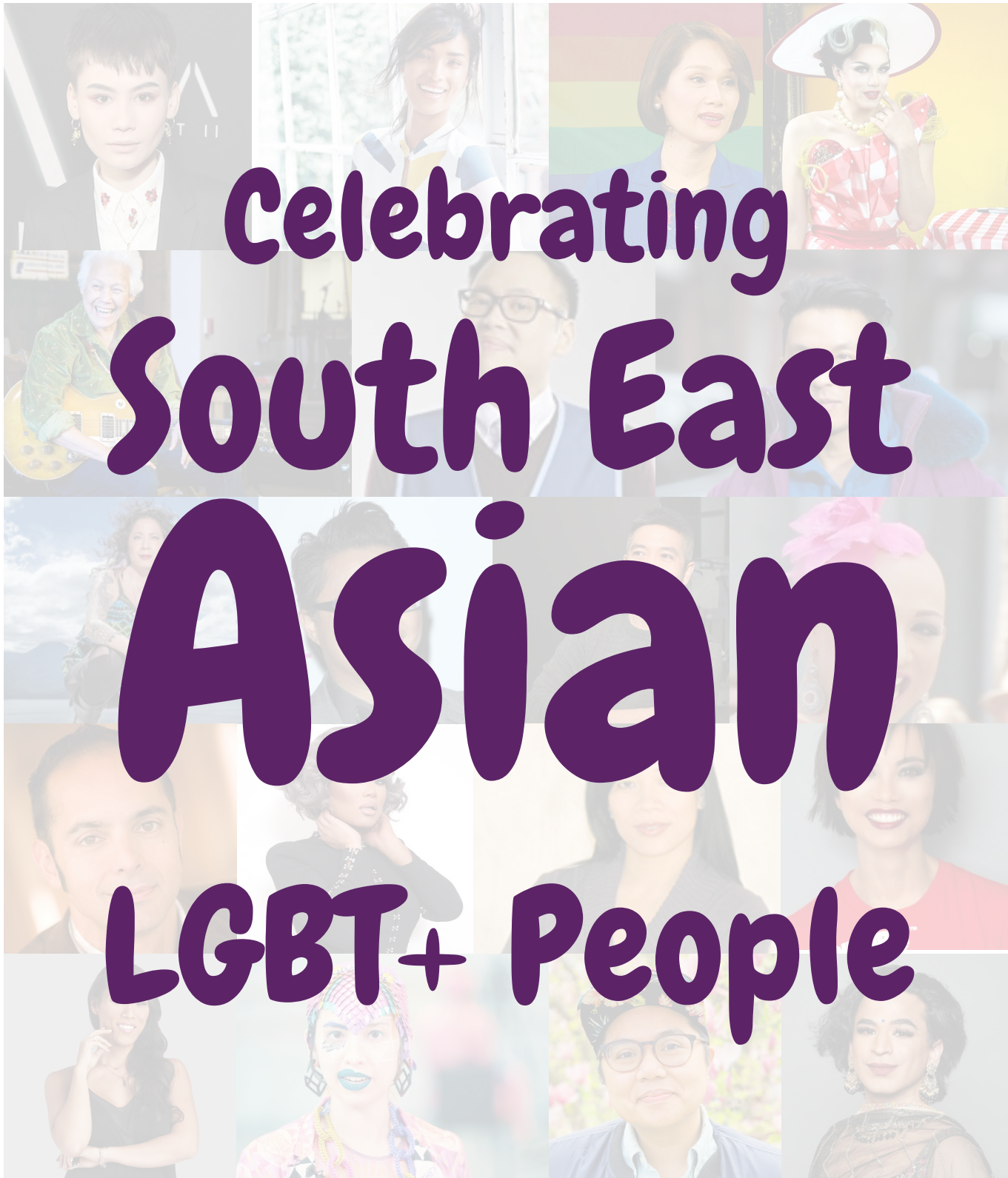

Children & young people often tell us that coming to Allsorts provides opportunities to meet 'others like me'. One of the challenges many of us may face when growing up as LGBT+ is that we are not presented with many or any positive LGBT+ role models in our immediate proximity, or in mainstream culture.

Those of us with intersecting or mixed marginalised identities are often most misrepresented or non-existent in mainstream culture and this is particularly true for LGBT+ people of colour. At Allsorts, we believe it is important to provide all LGBT+ children & young people with LGBT+ role models as a reminder of the endless ways there are to be LGBT+, that you are not alone, and there are people in all walks of life that have had similar experiences, and faced similar challenges to you.

**Allsorts of Visibility: Celebrating LGBT+ People of Colour** is a series of resources intended to celebrate and showcase LGBT+ people of colour. This edition focuses on **LGBT+ people from South East Asia and/or with South East Asian heritage**. The resources are by no means an exhaustive list of all LGBT+ people, nor can they ever be. But they are a continual work in progress, and an expanding collection. The people in these resources have been selected by Allsorts staff, young people, volunteers and supporters of the project.

Allsorts does not support every action of every individual within these resources. We believe it is important that it is acknowledged that no one is perfect, and have only withdrawn individuals from the resource under extreme displays of offensive or harmful attitudes and/or actions.

## IAN ALEXANDER

Actor

20 April 2001 - Present

Alexander is an American actor, known for his roles as Buck Vu on *The OA*, as Lev in *The Last of Us Part II*, and as Gray Tal on *Star Trek: Discovery*, who was the first transgender character in the *Star Trek* canon. He was born in Utah, to an American father and a Vietnamese mother who migrated to the United States from Vietnam.



## GEENA ROCERO

Model & Trans Advocate

1984 - Present

Rocero is a Filipino-born American model, TED speaker, and transgender advocate based in New York City. Rocero is the founder of Gender Proud, a media production company that tells stories of the transgender community worldwide to elevate justice and equality.

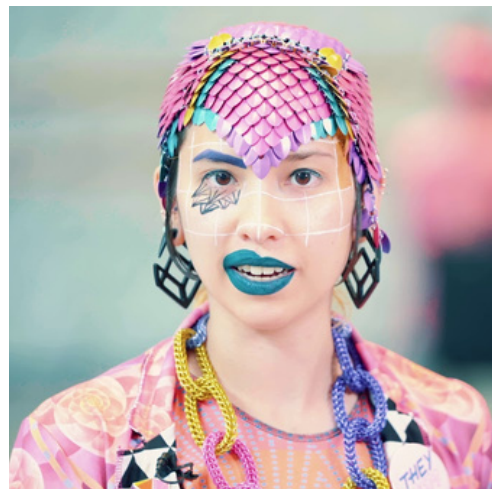


## AMAZIN LÊTHỊ

Athlete

? - Present

LêThị is a former weightlifter, competitive bodybuilder and published fitness author. Following her own experience of homelessness, she founded the Amazin LêThị Foundation and was the first LGBTQ Asian athlete to appear in the Rainbow Laces campaign.



## SKY CUBACUB

Designer

23 October 1991 - Present

Cubacub is a Filipinx-American designer who founded *Rebirth Garments*. Their own clothing needs lead to the idea of creating garments and accessories that were gender non-conforming, in any size range and met the needs of individuals with apparent and non-apparent disabilities and disorders.



## ALEC MAPA

Actor & Writer

10 July 1965 - Present

Mapa is an actor, comedian and writer who got his first professional break when he was cast to replace B. D. Wong for the role of Song Liling in the Broadway production of *M. Butterfly*. He has gained further prominence on a range of American sitcoms and has shown support to many LGBT+ projects.



## VINCENT RODRIGUEZ III

Actor

10 August 1982 - Present

Vincent Rodriguez III is a Filipino-American stage and television actor known for playing the male lead role of Josh Chan in The CW comedy-drama series *Crazy Ex-Girlfriend*. He has spoken about his yearning as a young, gay, Filipino man to tell his story and "show the world that Filipinos can be leading men too."



## NICO SANTOS

Actor

7 April 1979 - Present

Santos is a Filipino-American actor known for portraying Oliver T'sien in *Crazy Rich Asians* and sales associate Mateo Liwanag in the NBC series *Superstore*. On December 10, 2018, Santos was nominated for the Critics' Choice Television Award for Best Supporting Actor in a Comedy Series.



## GERALDINE ROMAN

Politician & Journalist

1967 - Present

Geraldine Roman is the first transgender person elected to the Congress of the Philippines, in 2016. She was also named as one of the 100 Leading Global Thinkers of 2016 by US-based *Foreign Policy* magazine; one of "13 Inspiring Women of 2016" list by *Time* magazine.



## AC DUMLAO

Influencer & Activist

Dumlao is a trans non-binary first-generation Filipinx-American New Yorker, who founded *Call Me They*. Their work in print, presentation and interviews has educated on issues of non-binary visibility, Asian & Filipino representation, "genderfull" fashion and aesthetics, and much more.

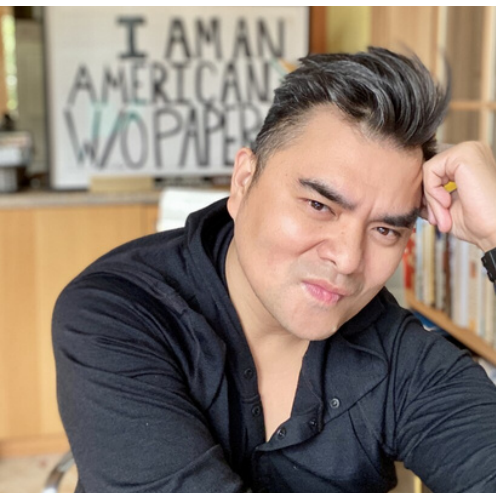


## PRABAL GURUNG

Fashion Designer

31 March 1979 - Present

Gurung is a fashion designer and founder of his own label, *Prabal Gurung*. He has designed for the likes of Michelle Obama and Kate Middleton, and has won an array of awards alongside being the founder of the *Shikshya Foundation*, a non-profit program to benefit underprivileged children in Nepal.



## JOSE ANTONIO VARGAS

Journalist

3 February 1981 - Present

Vargas is a journalist, filmmaker, and immigration rights activist. Born in the Philippines and raised in the United States from the age of twelve, he was part of *The Washington Post* team that won the Pulitzer Prize for Breaking News Reporting in 2008 for coverage of the Virginia Tech shooting online and in print.



## THAKOON PANICHGUL

Fashion Designer

1974 - Present

Thakoon Panichgul is a Thai-American fashion designer who since 2004 has designed for a wide range of celebrities, shows and stores. In 2017, he took a step back from the fashion world to create his own brand of clothing which aims to provide luxury at accessible prices.



## QUENTON ALLAN BROCKA

Director  
1972 - Present

Quenton Allan Brocka is a television and film director based in West Hollywood, California. He has directed and written a number of feature films and created an animated short in 1999 about a gay and lesbian couple having a baby together, which later led to the TV series *Rick & Steve* (2007-2009).



## ARI SOUTH

Fashion Designer  
? - Present

Nong Ariyaphon Southiphong (aka Ari South) is a fashion designer who gained national recognition as a designer on season 8 of *Project Runway* and seasons 3 and 6 of *Project Runway All Stars*. Following the her first season on the show, she came out as a trans woman and has been open about her experiences since.



## KARL WESTERBERG

Drag Queen  
10 August 1981 - Present

Westerberg, better known as drag personality Manila Luzon is a drag queen, recording artist, comedian and reality television personality who rose to public recognition after appearing on *RuPaul's Drag Race* in 2011. Since, Luzon has toured, released music, and appeared on *Drag Race Allstars*.



## CUC VU

Public Sector Director  
? - Present

Vu is the Director of Office of Immigrant & Refugee Affairs in Seattle, USA, and former Chief Diversity Officer at Human Right Campaign. Cuc has spent years in the labor movement working on cross-cutting issues, including immigration reform, equal pay, workers' rights & civic participation.



## JUJUBEE

Drag Queen  
21 June 1984 - Present

Airline Inthyrath, known by her stage name Jujubee, is an American drag queen, reality television personality, and recording artist from Massachusetts. Since appearing on *RuPaul's Drag Race* (2010), Jujubee has been a wider range of shows, films, music productions and theatre performances.



## CHRISTOPHER CABALDON

Politician  
12 November 1965 - Present

Cabaldon is a Filipino-American politician from California who served as mayor of West Sacramento and came out as gay in 2006. He is the longest-serving mayor in the city's history. He also represents the State of California on the Western Interstate Commission on Higher Education.



## JUNE MILLINGTON

Musician

14 April 1948 - Present

June Millington is a Filipino American guitarist, songwriter, producer, educator, and actress. She was the co-founder and lead guitarist of the all-female rock band *Fanny* (1970-1974). Millington went on to play solo, with several bands, founded her own record label & co-founded the Institute for the Musical Arts in California.



## MARGARITA ALCANTARA

Writer

10 June 1970 - Present

Margarita Alcantara is a writer and the creator of the print zine series *Bamboo Girl* (1995-2005). The zine highlighted content that commented on homophobia, racism and sexism. Alcantara notably featured Filipina authors: Ninotchka Rosca, Jessica Hagedorn, Perla Daly, in the series.



## RYAN ONG PALAO

Drag Queen

6 January 1982 - Present

Palao, also known by drag name, Ongina, is a Filipino-American drag performer and HIV activist who came to international attention on the first season of *RuPaul's Drag Race* and the fifth season of *RuPaul's Drag Race All Stars* and has appeared in a range of web series since.



## JAY NICOLAS SARIO

Fashion Designer

? - Present

Jay Nicolas Sario is a designer, visual merchandiser and stylist who appeared on *Project Runway* season 7, and has held prominent positions in brands including *GAP*, *Footlocker*, *Calvin Klein* and more.



## GUN KORAWIT BOONSRI

Model & Singer

6 August 1992 - Present

Gun is an openly gay Thai model, singer, and actor born in Chiang Mai. He graduated from the International Business University in Business Administration. He has been active since 2013 when he co-hosted the program "Five Live Fresh".

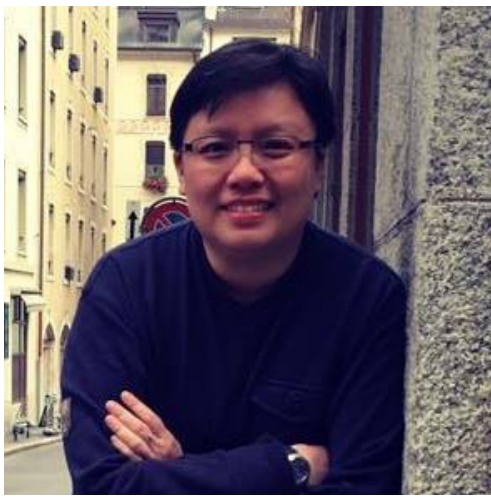


## ANGELA DIMAYUGA

Chef & Activist

1985 - Present

Dimayuga is an Filipino-American chef and political activist. She was an executive chef at Mission Chinese Food New York. Dimayuga was included in the Zagat's "30 Under 30" List in 2015 as an upcoming culinary star. As of 2018, she worked with The Standard hotel, which opened in London in 2019.



## JEAN CHONG

LGBT Rights Activist  
? - Present

Chong is a Singaporean LGBT rights activist. She first started in her activism by volunteering with a gay Christian support network, Safehaven, and became their first female vice chairperson. She co-founded Sayoni, a LGBT rights organization, and serves as one of the leaders of the ASEAN Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity and Gender Expression Caucus, an activist collective.



## BRETMAN ROCK

Influencer & Social Media Personality  
31 July 1998 - Present

Rock is a Filipino beauty influencer and social media personality based in Honolulu, Hawaii. He rose to fame as a creator on YouTube and Vine after one of his contouring videos went viral in 2015. Rock is known for making makeup tutorials and his humorous views on life. He has starred in his own reality TV show, MTV's Following: Bretman Rock in 2021 and was the first openly gay man to appear on the cover of Playboy.



## JOHN PHAM

Scientist & Editor-In-Chief  
? - Present

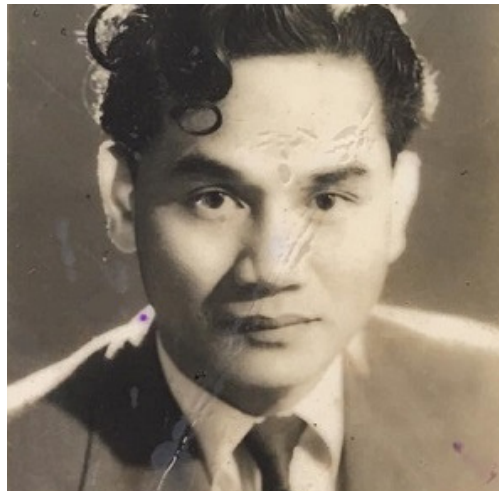
Pham is an American molecular biologist and editor-in-chief of Cell, a prestigious scientific journal. He is an advocate for inclusion and diversity, and he represents LGBTQ and Asian communities.



## PADDY CHEW

Public Figure  
29 March 1960 – 21 August 1999

Chew was the first Singaporean person with HIV/AIDS to come out to the general public. He became a public figure overnight, giving many interviews and inviting attention everywhere he went. His likeness and words on AIDS in Singapore were printed in local and foreign publications.



## XUAN DIEU

Poet & Journalist  
2 February 1916 – 18 Dec 1985

Dieu was a Vietnamese poet, journalist, story writer, and literary critic, known as a prominent figure of the twentieth-century Thơ mới (New Poetry) Movement. Although his love poems use expressions and pronouns that are commonly associated with heterosexual relationships, he was confirmed by his close friends, to be gay. The impact of his sexual orientation on his poetry remains a topic of discussion.



## BELL NUNTITA

Actress, Singer & DJ  
20 December 1983 - Present

Nuntita, is a Thai transgender actress, singer, entertainer, and radio DJ. She was part of a TV show called Venus Flytrap Search for the Missing Puzzle in 2007. She became popular after a performance during her audition on Thailand's Got Talent and became a YouTube hit when she first performed singing in a middleweight contralto voice before switching to a masculine baritone midway through the audition.



## EMMANUEL VASS

Musician  
? - Present

Vass is known as the Naked Pianist. A Pakistani-Filipino Yorkshireman, he was born in the Philippines and grew up in East Yorkshire England. He is an award-winning educator, who has broadcast on ClassicFM, BBC World Service, and BBC Radio 3, and featured across 30 countries. He now lectures at the world-renowned Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance, Greenwich, London.



## ANAN BOUAPHA

Activist  
? - Present

Bouapha, who is referred by the HuffingtonPost as the leader of the country's nascent LGBTI movement. In 2012, he founded Proud to Be Us Laos, the nation's first civil society network promoting equal rights for people with sexual and gender diversity communities. As President/Founder, he was instrumental in organising the first Pride event in Laos.



## NESTHY PETECIO

Boxer  
11 April 1992 - Present

Petecio is a Filipino amateur boxer. She won a silver medal in the inaugural women's featherweight event at the 2020 Summer Olympics, becoming the first Filipino woman to win an Olympic medal in boxing. She also won a silver medal at the 2014 World Championships and gold at the 2019 edition.



## MYO KO KO SAN

Model, Activist, Beauty Queen  
1 September 1994 - Present

Myo Ko Ko San is a Burmese transgender model, LGBT rights activist and beauty pageant titleholder who was elected Miss International Queen Myanmar 2014 and represented Myanmar at the Miss International Queen 2014. On 19 June 2018, she won the ASEAN - LGBT Community Pride Awards 2018.



## LLOYD CADENA

Vlogger & Radio Personality  
23 Sept 1993 - 4 Sept 2020

Cadena was a Filipino vlogger, radio personality, and author. He was one of the most popular YouTubers in his native Philippines, with over 5.86 million subscribers. Cadena rose to prominence on YouTube by documenting his travel, adventures, cooking, unboxing, challenge videos and pranks. He is considered one of the pioneers of YouTube vlogging in the Philippines.



## SUTAN AMRULL

Drag Queen & Make Up Artist  
14 June 1974 - Present

Amrull is an American drag performer and make-up artist who also uses the stage name Raja Gemini or simply Raja. Born in Bali Indonesia, he is best known for winning the third season of RuPaul's Drag Race and remains the only Asian American to win the show. He's also known for his makeup artistry on the reality television show America's Next Top Model.



## TANWARIN SUKKHAPISIT

Filmmaker & Politician  
23 October 1973 – Present

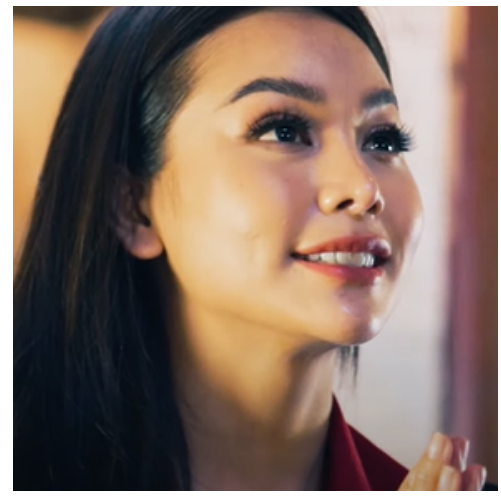
Tanwarin is a Thai filmmaker and politician. In the 2019 Thai general election, they were elected to the Thai parliament representing the Future Forward Party. Tanwarin is a kathoey, and became the first ever openly transgender member of parliament in Thailand's House of Representatives.



## DEREK NGUYEN

Filmmaker & Playwrite  
19 February 1973 - Present

Nguyen is a Vietnamese-American filmmaker and playwright best known for his 2016 feature film *The Housemaid* (Cô Hầu Gái). In 2019, Nguyen co-founded the production company *The Population* which focuses on producing feature films by or about women, people of color, LGBTQIA+, and other underrepresented groups.



## ENGFA WARAHA

Singer & Beauty Queen  
1995 - Present

Engfa is a Thai singer and beauty queen. She was previously known for her first appearance on the seventh season of the *Voice Thailand*. In 2022, she won the national contest of *Miss Grand Thailand 2022* as the representative of the capital city Bangkok and will represent the country at *Miss Grand International 2022* programmed to be held in Indonesia. She identifies as bisexual.



## INGRID NILSEN

YouTube Creator & UN Ambassador  
2 February 1989 - Present

Nilsen is an American YouTube personality who created the channel *Missglamorazzi* in 2009, because she wanted to share her feeling of confidence with other people and push herself to overcome her fear of public speaking. 2016, Nilsen was named one of the United Nations Change Ambassadors to the intergovernmental organisation. She is Thai and Norwegian descent.



## ELULA PERRIN

Author & Bar Owner  
1929 - 2003

Born in Hanoi, to an Eurasian mother and a French father, she emigrated to France in 1946. In 1969, she co-founded the *Katmandou*, the first nightclub for women in Paris. It is said that she was often referred to as "Grande prêtresse des nuits parisiennes féminines" ["Grand priestess of the female Parisian nights"].



## KHẢI ĐỊNH

Emperor  
8 October 1885 – 6 November 1925

Khải Định was the 12th Emperor of the Nguyễn dynasty in Vietnam, reigning from 1916 to 1925. Historical records and studies state that Emperor Khải Định only had homosexual desires. He rarely slept with his wives during his reign. He was close to his male guard, Nguyễn Đắc Vọng, and always slept with him.



## LEOW YANGFA

Editor & Executive Director  
? - Present

Yangfa is the Executive Director of Oogachaga Singapore's first community-based counselling, support and personal development agency for LGBTQ individuals, couples and families. He is editor of the book, *I Will Survive: Personal gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender stories in Singapore*. He is also featured in the book, *"SQ21: Singapore Queers in the 21st Century*.



## MICHAEL SHAOWANASAI

Artist & Actor  
11 May 1964 - Present

Shaowanasai is a Thai-American artist and actor who lives in Bangkok, Thailand. His works includes performance art, photography, video, film and installations. His works are often provocative, such as photographic portrait of himself as a Buddhist monk made up to look like a woman. He also ran the inaugural Gay and Lesbian Video Festival in Thailand in 2002.



## YOLLADA SUANYOT

Politician, Activist & Celebrity  
18 June 1983 - Present

Suanyot is a Thai politician and celebrity. Previous to entering politics, Suanyot had been a model and beauty queen, and was a member of the pop group Venus Flytrap. Suanyot is a transgender woman and founded and chairs the TransFemale Association of Thailand, which advocates for transgender rights.



## OCEAN VUONG

Author  
14 October 1988 - Present

Vuong is a Vietnamese American poet, essayist, and novelist. He is the author of *The New York Times* bestselling poetry collection, *Time is a Mother*, and *The New York Times* bestselling novel, *On Earth We're Briefly Gorgeous*, which has been translated into 37 languages. A recipient of a 2019 MacArthur "Genius" Grant, he is the author of the poetry collection, *Night Sky with Exit Wounds*.



## VŨ CÁT TƯỜNG

Songwriter & Record Producer  
2 October 1992 - Present

Tuong is a Vietnamese singer-songwriter, dancer, record producer, television judge and businesswoman who was a runner-up on the season 2 of *The Voice of Vietnam*. She is the first Vietnamese artist to have an album distributed by Universal Music Group, and the first Vietnamese artist having a bilingual album recorded in one of the most famous record studios in the world - United Recordings.



## NITI CHAICHITATHORN

TV Host, Actor & Producer  
1981 - Present

Niti is a Thai television host, creative, producer and actor, best known for co-hosting the lifestyle travel show *Toey Tiew Thai* and hosting the late-night talk show *Talk with Toey*. Both heavily feature queer-related themes. He won Best Entertainment Presenter/Host at the 22nd Asian Television Awards, for *Talk with Toey*, in 2017.



## **APICHATPONG WEERASETHAKUL**

Director & Producer  
? - Present

Weerasethakul is a Thai independent film director, screenwriter, and film producer. Working outside the strict confines of the Thai film studio system, he has directed several features and dozens of short films. Themes reflected in his films include dreams, nature, sexuality and Western perceptions of Thailand and Asia.



## **EILEENA LEE**

Activist  
? - Present

Lee is one of Singapore's most well known lesbian activists. She can be considered a leader of the second generation of lesbian activist. Lee was the founder of RedQueen!, Singapore's first and main lesbian mailing list. Eileena also helped launch Pelangi Pride Centre in 2002, Singapore's first LGBT community centre.



## **REV MIAK SIEW**

Pastor  
? - Present

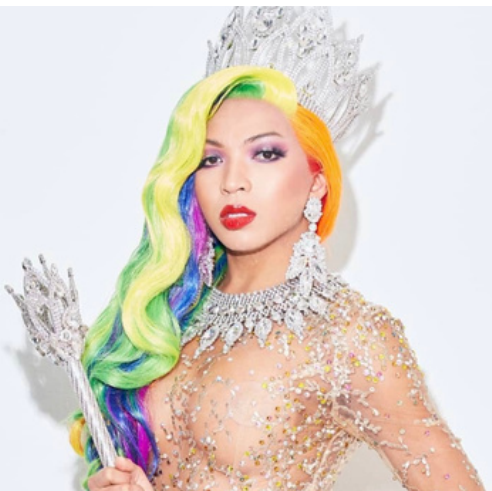
Siew is Singapore's first openly gay Christian pastor. He is executive pastor of the Free Community Church and a member of Singapore's pioneering LGBT advocacy group People Like Us.



## **HUNG HUYNH**

Chef  
25 January 1978 - Present

Huynh is a Vietnamese-born American chef, best known as the winner of the third season of Top Chef, a reality cooking competition series. He was the Executive Chef at Catch, The General, and Catch Miami. In 2022, Huynh signed on as the new Director of Culinary Innovation for Orlando-based Omei Restaurant Group.



## **ANGELE ANANG**

Drag Performer  
? - Present

Anang is a Thai drag performer, best known for winning the second season of Drag Race Thailand, the Thai spinoff of RuPaul's Drag Race. She was the first transgender winner in the franchise. She is known as "Beyoncé of Thailand" for her impersonation of the singer.



## **ANJANA SUVARNANANDA**

Activist  
? - Present

Suvarnananda is a Thai LGBT rights activist and founder of Anjaree Foundation. In 1998, Anjaree helped lift the ban on LGBT people appearing on television. In 2002, the group succeeded in getting the Thai Ministry of Health to publicly declare that homosexuality is not a mental illness.



## BOY ABUNDA

TV Host & Talent Manager  
29 October 1960 - Present

Abunda is a Filipino professor, television host, publicist and talent manager. He started Backroom, Inc managing singers and actresses and a public relations firm. He has been a host on a variety of television shows including Show and Tell, Startalk, The Buzz and The Bottom Line with Boy Abunda.



## LIN LINN

Make-Up Artist & Actress  
6 August 1982 - Present

Linn is a Burmese make-up artist turned actress after her two decades-long experience in the make-up industry. Linn was listed on The Myanmar Times "Top 10 Make-up artists" list in 2018. In 2019, she won the Fashion Award at the L'Oréal Myanmar red carpet galas and made her big-screen debut with the comedy film Kyar Kyar Kyite Kyite.



## PARINYA CHAROENPHOL

Thai Boxer, Model & Actress  
9 June 1981 - Present

Charoenphol is a Thai boxer, former muay Thai (Thai boxing) champion, model and actress. She was a kathoey, a Thai word referring to gender-nonconforming men or transgender women. Her story is related in the 2003 film Beautiful Boxer.



## PATARADANAI 'KOEN' SETSUWAN

Singer, Actor & Entrepreneur  
? - Present

Koen is from Thailand and was a member of boyband K-Otic between 2007 - 2012. During that time they toured extensively throughout Asia. Koen released a solo album and starred in three movies, two TV series and was the host of six TV shows. They are also an owner of a bakery chain in Bangkok. Currently they are studying Applied Psychology at Middlesex University London.



## RACHANA CHHOEURNG

LGBT Activist  
? - Present

Chhoeurng has been championing Cambodia's LGBT community since coming out as a lesbian. Chhoeurng now works with human rights group CamASEAN to tackle common issues the LGBT community face, such as forced marriage, psychological abuse and access to medical services, especially for the transgender community.



## SHIN THANT

Politician & Human Rights Defender  
19 May 1990 - Present

Shin is a Burmese LGBTQ+ rights activist, politician and human rights defender for LGBTQ+ people. She is one of the leading LGBTQ+ rights activists in Myanmar. Shin Thant is also a beauty queen who won Miss Trans Grand International Myanmar 2018, a beauty pageant for transgender women.



## **THAI NGUYEN**

Fashion Designer  
1980 – Present

Nguyen is a Vietnamese-American fashion designer and television personality. He is known for his role as the fashion expert on the Netflix series Say I Do. Nguyen has worked on Bravo's Launch My Line and RuPaul's Drag Race. During his career, Nguyen's designs have been seen on the red carpet for many celebrities.



## **OKKAR MIN MAUNG**

Actor, Model & Singer  
18 September 1985 - Present

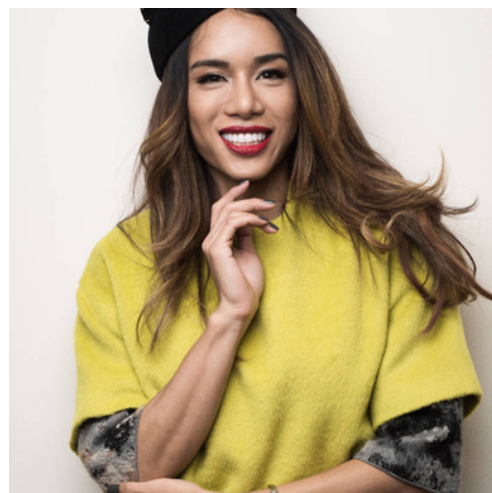
Maung is a Burmese actor, model, singer and male pageant winner who was crowned Mr. Tourism International 2016 at Manila, Philippines. He has starred as a leading role in a slew of local productions, from commercials to films, and has catwalked for several fashion events.



## **NADA CHAIYAJIT**

Activist  
? - Present

Chaiyajit is a trans activists from Thailand, who faced severe barriers in accessing her education. She challenge her university's regulations and became the first individual ever to succeed in using Thailand's new Gender Equality Act successfully to uphold the rights of trans individuals in the country.



## **PECHE DI**

Model, Agent, Actor & Dancer  
? - Present

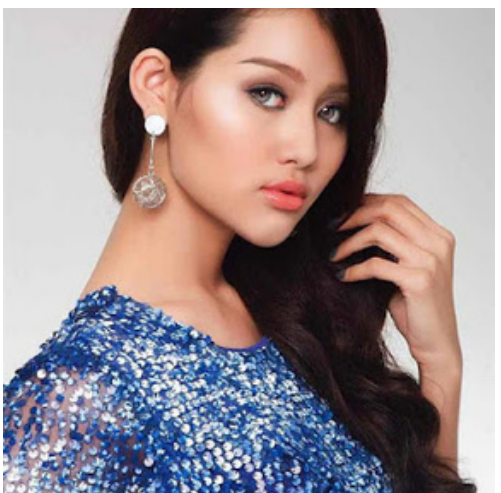
Peche Di is a transgender model, dancer, actress, videographer, and modeling agent. In 2014, Di was featured on the fifth anniversary cover of C☆NDY magazine along with 13 other transgender women. Di founded Trans Models NYC, a modeling agency focusing on transgender representation in modeling, in May 2015.



## **NOEL ALUNIT**

Novelist, Actor & Activist  
8 January 1968 - Present

Alunit is an American novelist, actor, and activist who was born in the Philippines. He was identified as one of the Top 100 Influential Gay People by Out Magazine in 2002. He has worked as an HIV/AIDS educator with the Asian Pacific AIDS Intervention Team in Los Angeles. His debut novel, Letters to Montgomery Clift, received the 2003 Stonewall Book Award from the American Library Association.



## **SWE SIN HTET**

Model & Beauty Queen  
16 November 1999 - Present

Swe Zin Htet is a Burmese model and beauty pageant winner. In 2019, as the reigning Miss Myanmar, she became the first out lesbian to compete in the 67-year-old Miss Universe contest. Homosexual conduct remains illegal in Burma, carrying a potential prison sentence of 10 years or more. She hopes her confident self-acceptance will inspire legislative and social change.
