Travel to remote First nations is required.

Qualifications:

- **This position is available only to a university or college graduate who has graduated within the last three years from an accredited college or university. The candidate must be a graduate from a post-secondary degree or diploma program. The position will be a first full-time employment in the candidate's field of study.**
- For this position, we are looking for graduates from diploma and degree programs in subjects related to the field of office/business administration, marketing, human resources, communications.
- This is a 12-month full-time internship (52 weeks; 40 hours/week).
