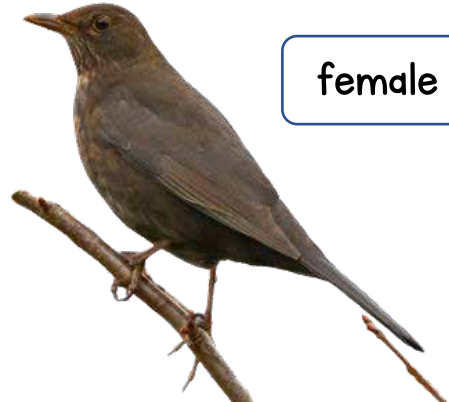

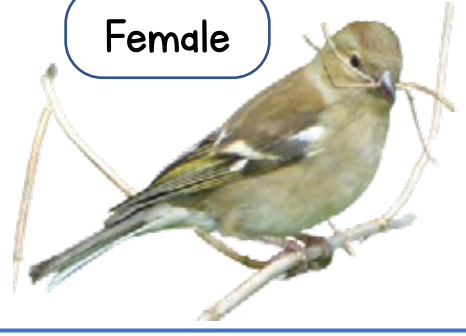

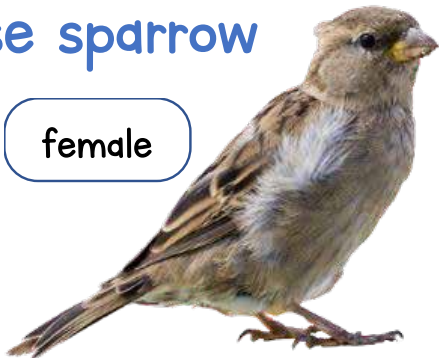

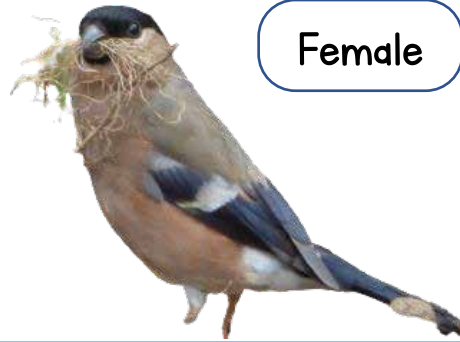

Questions for bird-watchers!

- Which species do you spot in flocks (groups) and which species do you only see single birds of?
- What is the most abundant (the one you see most of) species you see each day and over numerous days?
- Which is the rarest species you spot?
- Do you hear some species before you see them?
- Can you hear the different songs that different species make?
- Where do you spot different species? For example, do you see some species more often on the ground while only ever see other ones at the feeders and in the trees?
- If you put out different food for the birds, do different species seem to have different favourite foods?
- For species where the male and female look different, do you see the male or female bird more often?
- Does the weather affect how many birds you see?
