Mandatory lawn watering restrictions specify the days when you may water. These days depend on whether you have an odd- or even-numbered address, and the time of year. So unless your day and number are up, make sure those sprinklers stay down.

Know Your Days

Time of year	Homes with odd-numbered or no addresses	Homes with even-numbered addresses	Nonresidential properties
Daylight Saving Time	Wednesday/ Saturday	Thursday/ Sunday	Tuesday/ Friday
Eastern Standard Time	Saturday	Sunday	Tuesday

- Water only if necessary and not between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

- Restrictions apply to private wells and pumps, ground or surface water and water from public and private utilities.
- Some exceptions apply.
