We will provide on-site guidance to the staff of the child care, preschool, or recreational program your child attends, and provide you with support and guidance along the way. Our services are free, and include:

- In-classroom observation and assessment by our staff to help determine what support your child needs to be successful.
- Regular classroom updates so you can monitor your child's progress.
- Referrals and recommendations to services and programs that meet the specific needs of your family.
- Ongoing family support.
