Code of Conduct for Internet Use

Please read this document carefully with your child. Only once the agreement has been signed and returned will access to the Internet be permitted. If any pupil violates these provisions, access to the Internet will be denied and the student will be subject to disciplinary action in line with the school's behaviour policy.

- I will only use the Internet when supervised by a teacher or adult.
- I will never give out my personal information on the Internet, including my home address, telephone number or school name.
- I will never send any one my picture.
- I will never give my passwords to anyone, even my friends.
- I will never log onto the computers or any websites using someone else's username and password.
- I will never arrange to meet anyone that I meet online. If anyone asks to meet with me I will tell an adult straight away.
- I will never send unkind or bullying messages to anyone else.
- I will never respond to unpleasant or bullying emails and if I receive any I will tell an adult straight away.
- I will tell an adult straight away if I see or read anything that makes me feel worried or uncomfortable.
- I will not look for bad language or inappropriate images while I am online and if I find any I will tell an adult straight away.
- I will always be myself online and not pretend to be anyone or anything I am not.
- I will only access websites and material that is relevant to my school work.
- I know that my teacher and the internet service provider can check the websites I have been looking at.
- I know that the contents of any emails I send and receive will be monitored by adults.
- I will not use email to send or encourage material which is inappropriate, illegal, offensive or annoying or invades another person's privacy.
- I will not download any software from the Internet and if a website asks me to download anything I will tell an adult straight away.
- I know that information on the Internet is not always reliable and that some sources may need checking.
- I know that I will not be allowed to use the Internet in school if I do not abide by the code of conduct.
