How has the grant been spent or will it be spent?	Cost
<p>Coaching</p> <p>Using the grant we employ fully qualified specialist sports coaches from Game On. They plan and teach 1 lesson per week to each year group (Y1-6) for half a term.</p> <p>Impact: These lessons introduce children to a range of skills that are applicable across a wide variety of sports. This encourages pupils to take up sports and clubs after school and will have a long term impact on pupils fitness and involvement in sporting activities.</p> <p>Teachers observe the coaches teaching the sports improving teachers' skills and ensuring high quality teaching is sustained.</p>	<p>£1,365</p>
<p>Sports Partnership</p> <p>We buy membership in the Stoke Mandeville Sport Partnership which has given us access to well organised, high quality competitions and staff training.</p> <p>Level 2 Competitions this year include: Year R, 1 and 2 have completed multi-skills.
