<p><u>English</u></p> <p>As part of our space topic, the children will do English work based around 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy. They will also write fact files about space. They will continue to learn about spelling, punctuation and grammar and will build on their phonics knowledge.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>The children will continue to work on addition and subtraction on numbers within 20. This term they will also learn about measuring length and height and build on their learning about 2D and 3D shapes and patterns.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Seasonal changes - observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies</p> <p>Everyday Materials - We will name and describe materials and decide why certain objects are made from certain materials.</p>
<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Our computing topic is We are TV Chefs in which we will look at recipes and film ourselves making a recipe.</p>	<p><u>Topic – History</u></p> <p>As part of our space topic, we will be learning about Neil Armstrong and the Moon Landing. We will compare Neil Armstrong with other explorers.</p>	<p><u>Art and design</u></p> <p>We will design and make items for our Enterprise Week.</p>
<p><u>P.E.</u></p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>The children will learn about different styles of music including Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. They will have the chance to use their voices and play instruments</p>	<p><u>Citizenship</u></p> <p>We will learn about Healthy Relationships and who can help us if we have a problem.</p>
<p><u>British values/SMSC</u></p> <p>Children will discuss the importance of exploration and how it benefits us as a culture.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>In this topic the children will be looking at the Creation Story in Genesis1 of the Old Testament and will learn that this story is both a Christian and a Jewish one. They will learn about ways in which Christians show their thanks to God.</p>
