Vero Beach Vero Beach Senior Center to be remodeled

VERO BEACH — Senior Resource Association has selected Croom Construction Co. from among 12 other builders to renovate the Vero Beach Senior Center, 694 14th St.

The renovation will give the center a modern look and feel, allowing the association to enhance its activities and offerings for seniors in Indian River County, association president and CEO Karen Deigl said.

According to Joe Kirby, estimator for Croom Construction, the building's exterior will receive new storefront windows and doors, stucco, and covered walkways. The interior will have new ceilings, doors, tile, and electrical lighting.

"The current building has a tired look," Kirby said. "It's going to get a face-lift, both inside and out."

The renovations are scheduled to begin in November and will be complete by late January 2010. Due to the remodeling, the senior center's programs have been temporarily relocated to the city of Vero Beach Recreation Department Leisure Square Fitness Center, 1705 16th St., and to St. Francis Manor, 1750 20th Ave.

The remodeled center will be renamed Schumann Hall after the Schumann Foundation, the leading donor to the project.
