



New Life Academy is preparing for in-person instruction with remote options for the fall of 2020. There will be four days on-site at school and one day off-site. NLA will follow specific health precautions which will be in accordance with our local, state, and federal requirements.

- Daily symptom screenings & temperature checks of school staff & students - If their temperature is greater than 100.4 degrees, they will be sent home and not be able to attend school until they adhered to school guidelines.
- Appropriate PPE including face coverings - All students and school staff must wear face coverings during the school day except for eating. All visitors must wear face coverings.
- Require social distancing - Students will have the ability to learn and work with 6ft distance between their peers in each classroom. Social distance must be maintained.
- Hand washing and hand sanitizer - Students will wash their hands and/or receive hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer, sinks, and handwashing mobile stations will be provided throughout the school building.
- Schoolwide cleaning and disinfection - deeper daily sanitizing and cleaning protocols will be performed.
- Outdoor learning will be encouraged and settings established.
- School day will start at 8:45 a.m. and end at 2:30 p.m. Additional time will be provided for supporting students with online learning.
- Google classroom will be the platform that students access to manage their work, discussions, and assignments.
- Google Meets will be one of New Life Academy's primary platforms for live (synchronous) virtual class meeting spaces.
- Extended care will remain available at 8:00am and until 3:30pm, with limitations on after school enrichment.
- GradeLink will continue to be NLA's main information system. Parents can access grades, announcements, and make school payments.
