Individuals with completed higher education can come to Germany in order to find a job

- ◇ Individuals who have a German university degree or one recognized in Germany are allowed to come or stay in Germany to find a job.
- ◇ Their residence permit is given for 6 months and lets the person scan the labor market and find a job position in Germany, that takes advantage of their qualifications. After receiving a job offer, the residence permit can be extended.
- ◇ Considering your academic background, experience, and qualifications, GERMELA will be happy to assist you in applying for a job-seeking visa, and support you in finding the appropriate job position as well as guiding you throughout the whole procedure of receiving a long-term residence permit.*

Necessary Documents:

- ◇ 2 completed applications
- ◇ 3 passport size photographs
- ◇ Valid national passport
- ◇ Criminal record
- ◇ Contract/Job-offer with mentioned salary
- ◇ CV, diplomas, qualification certificates, etc.
- ◇ Bachelor degree certificate from a university recognized by Germany (you can find information about the validity of your university on the <http://anabin.kmk.org/>)
- ◇ Personal/Individual status record and Individual Civil Registry Record
- ◇ Motivation letter in which you describe how and where you are going to look for a job
- ◇ Documents confirming the means of subsistence
- ◇ Confirmation letter from your health insurance stating coverage for emergency medical or hospitalization with a minimum of 30,000 Euros coverage
