- ◇ Under certain conditions, graduates of German universities are also entitled to a settlement permit for minimum two years (section 18b of the Residence Act).

Necessary Documents:

Means of subsistence – 7908 Euro per year (personal financial statements of the last three months, scholarship award certificate, fixed deposit statement “Sperrkonto”, written confirmation of parents or sponsor that he/she will cover your costs, or other)

- ◇ 2 completed applications
- ◇ 3 passport size photographs
- ◇ Valid national passport
- ◇ Students admitted to studies: letter of acceptance
- ◇ Students applying for studies: prove of application submitted to a German institute or of correspondence with a German institute.
- ◇ Authenticated certificates of earlier education (formal and informal)
- ◇ Personal/Individual status record; Individual Civil Registry Record
- ◇ Confirmation letter from your health insurance stating coverage for emergency medical or hospitalization with a minimum of 30,000 Euros.
