DAY CARE	£65 Per Day
RESPIRE CARE **	£110 Per day
PERMANENT RESIDENCY	£725 Per week

Care fee’s include nutritional food 24 hours a day with a fantastic range of choices, 3 hot meals available daily, laundry, 24 hr person centered care from a highly motivated and well trained team, fully furnished rooms, access to all the most up to date equipment, services and facilities, TV points and WIFI, we also provide in-house entertainment and day trip activities*

* Some activities and day trips may be chargeable depending on the level of investment and involvement.

** For respite stays we charge an initial £40 care plan set-up fee which would be refunded should the stay ever become permanent.

Fee’s do not include: Private chiropody, hairdressing, newspapers or toiletries. Repeat appointments requiring chaperoning will need to be discussed on an individual basis and may incur a cost. Although we are registered as a residential home we do use the district nursing service and can cater for higher dependent individuals based on an assessment. Please enquire at the home

HOW TO APPLY FOR YOUR CARE

If you are thinking of Silver Oaks to provide your care there are a few steps that we need to take together and the first one is a visit to the home to have a look round and pick up an application pack.

In the application pack you will find a pre-assessment form that you can work through with your relative,

advice and guidance on how to fill this in will be provided when you come to see us.

Once filled in please return it to us and we will then work with you to establish the most suitable direction for your care needs.

If we can meet your care needs and you like the

home then we would need to establish when we would be able to offer you a place.

Whilst the application process is underway we would organise a visit to familiarise you with our home, maybe have lunch and see how we operate, thus making the move more comfortable.
