

## ***Job Description: Transitional Justice Consultancy***

**Position:** Consultant

**Job location:** Remote

**Duration:** 8 to 10 weeks

**Background:** *We are a Libyan and international independent non-governmental organisation, committed to achieving justice and respect for human rights in Libya. Our vision is of a Libya which embodies the values and principles of human rights and the rule of law and is a society committed to justice. We seek justice in Libya through advocacy and outreach, accountability, transitional justice initiatives and capacity building, underpinned by our own independent research.*

### **Your tasks and responsibilities:**

You will be working independently to conduct research on perceptions of justice, as part of our Accountability and Transitional Justice (A&TJ) Programme, in partnership with the International Centre for Transitional Justice (ICTJ). In this role you will work both independently and with local civil society to implement a comprehensive survey to determine perceptions of justice and accountability within Libya. Based on your findings, you will conduct a report and make clear policy recommendations. The exact terms of reference will be developed jointly with you.

### **Desired qualifications and skills:**

#### *Education*

- A higher degree in a related subject, ideally in conflict and transitional justice

#### *Experience*

- Demonstrable experience researching topics of transitional justice is required.

#### *Skills and Knowledge*

- Proficient research skills
- Proven experience in conducting independent research, including in devising and implementing methodologies and demonstrable experience in designing and analysing surveys
- Familiar with concepts of Transitional Justice
- Ability to draft and edit high quality written material accurately, concisely and appropriately for a particular audience
- Knowledge of Libyan context highly desirable, but not required

#### *Languages*

- Excellent written and oral communication in English is essential, and in Arabic is desirable. Please comment on your level in both languages as part of your application.
