



Job Description: Consultant for Development of E-learning Platform

Position: Consultant

Location: Remote

Duration: At least 20 days through until end of June 2021

We are a Libyan and international independent non-governmental organisation, committed to achieving justice and respect for human rights in Libya. Our vision is of a Libya which embodies the values and principles of human rights and the rule of law and is a society committed to justice. We seek justice in Libya through advocacy and outreach, accountability, transitional justice initiatives and capacity building, underpinned by our own independent research.

Tasks and responsibilities:

The Consultant will be engaged to develop an online e-learning platform (the Platform) for a series of three two-week courses designed to build the capacity of participants to document and investigate gross human rights violations and serious international crimes. Each of the three courses will focus on a different topic, and should be designed to be informative, engaging and interactive, through a combination of live Zoom calls, short pre-recorded videos, case studies, multiple choice quizzes based on required reading distributed to participants in advance, and practical exercises. We are currently considering whether to have participants pass some sort of test for them to be able to access the next course. All participants will also be expected to deliver specific assignments in-between the different courses.

The Platform should include a chat or breakout room function to allow participants to discuss with each other, and to raise questions with relevant experts who will function as trainers and mentors.

LFJL will provide all of the substantive content for the training (videos, quizzes, exercises, reading lists etc) (some material will be in English, and be translated by LFJL into Arabic). The course will be in Arabic.

The Consultant is expected to build the Platform, and to be on stand-by for any IT related questions and issues that may come up throughout the training.

More detailed terms of reference will be developed jointly with the Consultant.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Four years' relevant experience is required.
- Degree or equivalent qualification in information technology, adult/online learning or other related area, or six years' experience.
- Knowledge and hands on experience of various online learning tools is required.
- Proven experience delivering similar projects.
- Experience delivering e-learning projects in the field of human rights or international law (or related areas) is an asset.
- Ability to meet deadlines.
- Ability to plan, organise, implement and report on work.
- Professional proficiency in English and Arabic is required.

Remuneration:

To be agreed dependent on experience.
