Online Privacy Policy

The League of Women Voters of New Jersey is committed to ensuring the privacy and security of visitors to www.lwvnj.org. Additionally, we urge visitors to take steps to protect their personal privacy such as safeguarding passwords and using a firewall.

This privacy statement applies to the League of Women Voters of New Jersey website whose homepage is www.lwvnj.org. This is not a privacy statement for blogs, forums, or social networking sites.

What information does www.lwvnj.org collect from website visitors and how is this information used?

When you visit the League of Women Voters of New Jersey website, your browser automatically sends us an Internet Protocol ("IP") address and certain other information (including the type of browser you use). We will use this IP address and other information to manage our website. Other automatically collected data that we track includes the number and frequency of hits per page, as well as length of website visit. We use this information to analyze website traffic and determine the usefulness of information we put on our website.

We also collect voluntarily submitted data, which is information that you may voluntarily provide (such as your name, address, email address, etc) when you participate in certain activities on the League of Women Voters of New Jersey website such as:

- Join or renew your membership
- Make a financial contribution
- Sign up for the League of Women Voters of New Jersey email updates
- Register online for an event
- Participate in any activity that requires your voluntarily submitted data

Like many websites, the League of Women Voters of New Jersey uses "cookie" technology. A "cookie" is a piece of data stored on the user's machine that enables the browser to store and recall information. This cookie is used to facilitate access to www.lwvnj.org. Some portions of the League of Women Voters of New Jersey website are hosted by vendors providing services to the League and these vendors have their own privacy policies.

How do we protect your information?

The League of Women Voters of New Jersey takes every precaution available to us to protect our website users' information. When users submit sensitive information via the website, their information is protected both online and off-line.
