## Lease Payment Adjustment:

The basic rates include higher distribution system costs associated with service in rural territory. For irrigation Customers in urban rate areas, the lower distribution costs are offset by the inclusion of the lease payment costs, resulting in the same basic irrigation rates, subject to the following adjustments, applied to irrigation Customers in both urban and rural rate areas.

Customers that are in urban rate areas, as established by distribution system boundary or rate area maps, and served from distribution facilities for which the District does not have a lease payment or debt service obligation will have the basic rates (excluding PCA but including applicable power factor adjustment) adjusted to <u>exclude</u> such lease payment and debt service costs by the following formula: Basic Rates x (1 - applicable lease payment or debt service obligation percentage).

Customers that are in rural territory served from distribution facilities leased by the District upon whose revenues the District is obligated to make a lease payment will have the basic rates (excluding PCA but including applicable power factor adjustment) adjusted to <u>include</u> the lease payment by the following formula: Basic Rates ÷ (1 - applicable lease payment obligation percentage).

# **Gross Revenue Tax Adjustment:**

Customers located inside the corporate limits of a community, upon whose revenues the District is obligated to pay a five percent (5%) Gross Revenue Tax, will have the basic rates (including PCA and applicable power factor and lease payment credit adjustments) adjusted to <u>include</u> the five percent (5%) Gross Revenue Tax by the following formula: Basic Rates ÷ 0.95.

OPERATION HOURS: The time of use meter shall be programmed for the months June through September as follows:

- 1. On-Peak Period 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Central Daylight Savings Time) of each day Monday through Friday inclusive.
- 2. Mid-Peak Period 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (Central Daylight Savings Time) of each day Monday through Friday inclusive.
- 3. Off-Peak Period 10:00 p.m. to the following 10:00 a.m. (Central Daylight Savings Time) of each day Monday through Friday and all day on Saturday, Sunday, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

The District reserves the right to revise these hours of operation should load conditions change but shall not reduce the operation hours below 12 hours per day for the Off-Peak Period.

MINIMUM ANNUAL BILL: Fixed Charge, subject to applicable Base Rate Adjustment.

FIXED CHARGE DETERMINATION: The demand for determining the Fixed Charge will be the highest measured 30-minute demand in the summer months of June through September of the preceding year. For new installations or when no demand was recorded from the prior Irrigation Season, the demand used in determining the Fixed Charge for the current Irrigation Season will be the product of the pump motor nameplate horsepower rating plus ½ of the combined nameplate horsepower rating of all motors on the irrigation drive mechanism multiplied by a factor of 0.829. This factor is based on 1 HP being equivalent to 0.829 kW, which assumes 90 percent motor efficiency. Where the nameplate of the motor is not available, the horsepower used in the calculation will be determined by an actual measurement of horsepower input to the motor operating under

CONVERSION CHARGE: A Conversion Charge of \$20.00 will be assessed for any Irrigation Service Rate Schedule change occurring between April 15 and September 30.

USE OF SERVICE FOR PURPOSES OTHER THAN IRRIGATION: At locations where the District has provided facilities for irrigation service, the Customer may use the facilities for purposes other than irrigation provided such service may be supplied from the District's facilities serving the irrigation pump. The other loads cannot exceed the capacity of the transformers which are sized to the irrigation load and cannot be operated when the irrigation pump is operating.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- 1. Service will be furnished under the District's Retail Service Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Extensions made for service under this Rate Schedule are subject to the provisions of the District's "General Extension Policy for Retail Electric Services and Facilities".
- 3. The District's General Customer Service Charges Rate Schedule shall apply.
- 4. Usage shall be prorated for application of a change in rate or changing from summer to winter or winter to summer rates. Such proration shall be accomplished by utilizing either the Customer's actual usage in each time period, or by fractionalizing the Customer's total usage according to the number of days of service corresponding to each time period by using the District's billing system.
- 5. The Customer shall not be permitted to change from the Irrigation Service Rate Schedule (IRRIG-1) or from the Interruptible Irrigation Service Rate Schedule (IRRIG-3) to the Off-Peak Irrigation Service Rate Schedule (IRRIG-2) during the Irrigation Season. New or inactive irrigation customers shall not be permitted to start service on IRRIG-2 after April 15<sup>th</sup> for the next Irrigation Season.
- 6. The District shall provide and install a suitable time of use meter.
