

## MODERN DAY SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING POLICY STATEMENT

To state Edge Interactive Ltd's Modern Day Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy for 2021 to 2022.

### Policy Statement

Edge Interactive Ltd acknowledges the provisions of the Modern Day Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency and accountability across the organisation and within its operations with specific regards to the use of its suppliers for goods and services.

Edge Interactive Ltd are satisfied through its own due diligence processes that there is no evidence of any act of modern day slavery or human trafficking within any aspect of the whole organisation. The company recognises that due diligence processes and reporting are essential management tools that improve risk identification and long-term social, environmental as well as financial performance.

The adopted due diligence process incorporates the regular review of the contractor and supplier approval processes, regularly checking references and ongoing planning to similarly check the procedures undertaken by these suppliers, thus guarding against modern day slavery or human trafficking. Understandably, imported goods provided from sources externally to the United Kingdom or European Union may potentially be more at risk of human trafficking or slavery issues, therefore Edge Interactive Ltd will increase the level of due diligence and monitor these sources used.

Edge Interactive Ltd will not knowingly engage with any contractor or supplier that may be involved in human trafficking or slavery and will take appropriate action as a responsible company, should any concerns become apparent either directly or brought to our attention. The Board of Directors, the Management and all employees of Edge Interactive Ltd are informed of this policy statement and will take responsibility for its implementation.
