SUBJECT: 2019-2020 Creative Teaching Grant Applications (Fall Deadline: **Tuesday, October 1, 2019**)

The Butler Area School District is now receiving applications for creative teaching grant programs funded by The Golden Tornado Scholastic Foundation, Inc. The Golden Tornado Scholastic Foundation has appropriated a pool of up to \$30,000 to be used for educational creative teaching grant awards. Individuals may request up to the total amount available, \$30,000, but if other grants are approved, the full amount will not be available. The Creative Teaching Grant Review Committee will place a heavier emphasis on creative and innovative projects that promote excellence in teaching and learning. The grant application and scoring procedures give more weight to project proposals that promote these types of learning activities.

Applications may be picked up in the Principal's Office of your respective school(s) or on the Foundation website at [www.goldentornadoscholasticfoundation.org](http://www.goldentornadoscholasticfoundation.org) Timeline for submission and determination of recipients are as follows:

- ❖ Completed applications with supporting documentation are to be submitted to your building principal no later than Tuesday, October 1, 2019.
- ❖ Applications will be reviewed by the building principals from October 1, 2019, through October 31, 2019, with recommendations made to the district Superintendents by November 1, 2019. *The building principal recommendation section must be completed on the application prior to being submitted to the district Superintendents. Please forward applications to the attention of Ellen Scott/Administration Building.*
- ❖ District Superintendents will review the applications and make recommendations to the appointed Foundation Board Grant Subcommittee by November 29, 2019.
- ❖ The Foundation Board Grant Subcommittee will review all applications recommended by the district Superintendents and make recommendations to the Foundation Board as a whole at the January 16, 2020 meeting. The Foundation Board will vote to accept the recommendations of the Grant Subcommittee and the recipients will be notified no later than January 31, 2020.
- ❖ Funding for the approved grants will be available February 1, 2020. Materials, supplies, or contracts for speakers are to be processed through the building principal's office on a purchase order no later than May 15, 2020. The purchase order is to be forwarded to the Business Office for final approval and processing.

Creative teaching grants will be awarded to applicants who develop projects that promote excellence in teaching and learning.

- 1) All grant winners will be required to prepare a 1-3 minute video and/or photo presentation which showcases the project and outcomes. One or more grant winners will be asked to present at the FAB Showcase each year to highlight grant program and benefits to children as well as detail how fundraising activities directly impact students.
- 2) All grant winners who seek continuation of their project, either with or without funding through the Foundation, will have to provide a brief, written essay of the educational outcomes.
- 3) All grant requests shall be grade appropriate and shall complement current curriculum.
- 4) Grant request may encompass projects, technology or student experiences.
- 5) All grant requests must detail how the project, technology or experience supplements curriculum while being new and innovative.
