



Dear Friends,

Greetings from Poland! I was waiting with this newsletter until we have more certain update.

First of all let me thank you for all your prayers. I am writing to share with you that definitely God has answered them! As I wrote in our previous newsletter in the middle of January we started regular meetings with potential converts in Łuków. We decided to use John Blanchard's book "Right with God" published by Legatio which is the best evangelistic book in polish I know (praise God for Legatio and those who support it!).

After one and a half months I have no reason to doubt that Karolina, Ewa, Ela and Mariola are born again. For two of them it must have happened in the last few months.

It looks like **Ewa** was born again a few years ago, but since she had no contact with a gospel preaching church, she was not led in her faith and she did not understand properly what happened in her life and what the Lord is calling her to do.

Mariola is in a kind of similar situation. It looks like she was born again many years ago. Some time ago unfortunately she stopped coming to our Thursday meetings and Sunday services. We do not know the reason. Join us in prayer that she will be baptised and will join the congregation.

Karolina – There is clear repentance in her. She said, "I know that it is by faith alone in a vicarious death of Christ, but also conversion must go along with turning from sin". She runs a business where not everything was 100% legal (nothing untypical for Poland - in fact it is hard to run a business in this country and keep everything legal!) but she is not doing it alone, so she was planning to talk to her business associate that they have to change something or she will leave. She was praying for the solution and thank God, He answered her prayers quickly! Next week her friend told her that they must shut the business till March as she leaves Poland and fly to her partner in Thailand. This is far too fast as they have some clients that count on them (they sell wedding dresses) so they agreed to cooperate till July.

At the same time she decided to tell her mum that she no longer goes to the Catholic Church and the reaction was awful. She told her to "get out of her face". Over the next few weeks it was a nightmare. She renounced her, and she wanted to persuade her son in law to divorce her! About a week later she apologised but she told her not to tell her dad that she is in a different church. Sooner or later she will tell the whole family. She does not want to carry this burden but also she says that since she wants to be baptised and she wants to give testimony of her faith she feels uncomfortable to hide this information from her family. She said: "what can I do that they think like this about me... I am not going to change my faith because they do not like it...". She is a wonderful testimony and great encouragement for us! **Please do not forget about her in your prayers!**

Ela – there is a visible change in her life. When I asked her what does this change look like, she said that she has an unexplained peace in her heart. I asked so many questions to understand what does she mean and let me

put it as simple as this: she now lives in a different reality. She does not have to fear anything as she knows that God has control over her life. Ela is a nurse and her friends in the hospital gave her a nickname “the saint”, since now she is so calm, patient and joyful. What a wonderful testimony!

Agnieszka is a friend of Karolina. Karolina invited her to our Sunday service and she came 3 times. Last Thursday we also had a meeting and a long chat about her life. She is very open to talk about the Protestant faith and strongly against the Catholic Church as an institution (horrible experiences). We are going to focus on the Gospel, again we will use John Blanchard’s book. Please pray for her salvation!

Friends! God has his people in Polish cities, towns and villages, but they have no places to go! Some of them having limited understanding of the Scriptures attend Catholic Masses at the same time feeling they are part of a deceived church. But often they have no alternative! Some of them will search for an alternative and will land up in very unhealthy churches that either preach a very distorted gospel or do not preach the gospel at all! There are hundreds of people a year who will get to know the real gospel from the internet but nearly no one will join any evangelical church! In Poland there is about nine hundred cities and between six and seven hundred without ANY evangelical church! We simply need to plant churches!

Family – My grandpa died of cancer on Wednesday 13th March. The last few weeks were really hard for our family. I had very limited chance to share the gospel with him. When he was in hospital we read the first 3 chapters of John’s Gospel twice (two days) and Daga read two chapters of Ephesians. Please join me in prayer for my grandma that I will have opportunity for sharing the gospel with her.

New Ministry – In the next newsletter I am going to share with you our vision for a new ministry in our church which we hope will be very helpful for the whole Church in Poland. For now we call it Ewangelia W Centrum (The Gospel in the Centre) but it might change. At the end of March Ben will fly to the USA to have some meetings regarding this idea, but I will tell you more once we have more information.

Praise God for answered prayers! Praise God for the encouragement we experienced in this arduous work of church planting! Praise God for 160 people at the marriage conference we organised in Siedlce with Dr Tim Savage! Very edifying time and very positive feedback!

Please pray for the church plant in Łuków. Pray for new leaders, pastors, preachers, church planters. Pray for the “Journey through the Old Testament” conference on 27th April with John Brand that we organise in Warsaw in cooperation with two other churches and EBC.
