We already feel quite fine, though we understand that our lives will not be the same again as before grandma's death. As C.S. Lewis rightly observed in one of his books: "The death of a beloved is an amputation", so we all feel like a big part of our own life was taken from us forever. My granny played a very important role in our family. She was the link that was connecting all the family together. We try to keep in touch with everyone but it's not going to be as natural as usual.

Many of you probably would like to know if there is any new info about the case. There is, but I cannot share too much for the sake of the investigation. The prosecutor has a pretty probable version of the story and identified a suspect, and although it will not be easy to catch him we have hope that sooner or later it will happen.

Now there is some very good news. Dagmara has a new job in a supermarket and on Saturday she signed a contract for a year. That makes our situation more stable. Also it will change our habits a bit. Now together we wake up 4-5 am, and I either give Daga a lift to work or pick her up from work after the night shift. We are so thankful to God for this new job opportunity!

If you would like to pray for us, here are some pointers:

Please keep praying for me and my family – Although I feel fine, I am sure that my brain does not work the same as before. It's hard to explain it and I am not sure how much it is linked to recent tragedy but I am finding creative work very difficult for me now.

Please pray for the fruit of our online ministry – Such a huge opportunity for the gospel to be preached now. Please pray for many souls to be saved in this strange time.
