Dear Friends,

Greetings from Poland where we enjoy what we call a “polish golden autumn”!

Wonderful season with one exception. Often it causes many health problems. So it was in my case! (Here is looking back a few days prior to Adam’s deputation and we can give thanks that Adam is now on his deputation!

Last Tuesday I went with my quite serious health issues to my GP. It turned out that for over a month I was having pneumonia. Atypical pneumonia, which is called “walking pneumonia”. I was walking with it feeling quite well (apart from some minor symptoms). Meanwhile I received two vaccinations. Perhaps it lowered my immunity a bit. Eventually everything ended up with an acute chest infection.

Since Tuesday I have been taking two antibiotics, and it looks like it works quite well. I feel better now, but I still should isolate myself. Next Tuesday I have a follow-up appointment and we will see in what condition I am.

I really hope I will fully recover before my flight to the UK. Nearly every time I visited the UK in the past in autumn or spring I was catching some infections. I pray and hope that it will not be the case this time!

Daga is so happy with her new job. The quality of our life has changed dramatically (for better). The work is less hard, everything is very well organised, she earns better, the atmosphere at work is very good, her shifts are very regular and sensible, and they nearly don’t affect me. Praise the Lord for this blessing, and we really mean it. Daga changed her job to a new one in pretty miraculous circumstances, but there is no space to write about it here. You can take it to the bank - God answered her prayer and intervened!

We recently bought a wee car with LPG (assumedly for Daga), but before she will pass the exam I will be using it for our commuting. It is much cheaper to run, and considering galloping inflation in Poland and the raise of a policy rate, and higher prices, it helps us quite seriously.

Daga still needs to have some practice before she will take the driving exam. Perhaps, she will sign up for one in the beginning of a new year.

The church

Thank you for your prayers for people. There is a visible progress in Adam’s and Konrad’s life. It may be that they are born again. Konrad is even quite sure about that. Adam has nearly every fruit that tells me that he is regenerated, but he himself is not sure about that. He might be a bit severe for himself. Please pray for the assurance for both of them and some convincing proof for that.

Konrad’s wife is pretty hostile to anything different than a Catholic Church but seeing the change in his life she is kind of relenting. Pray for her too!

We have come back to the regular midweek prayer meeting where currently (apart from the Bible obviously) we read together J.I. Packer’s “Knowing God”.

There are few projects that we will be working on over the next months. One of them is this: Just recently one of the publishers in cooperations with The Gospel in the Centre published a part of John Piper's Solid Joys. It is

published as an advent devotional. We are going to buy 100 copies and let each of our members distribute them to their friends and families before December. Join us in prayer!

We are also going to replace our old signboards around the building, hoping it will make us much more visible. Jan (an elder and our webmaster) is creating a promo video of our church for our website. Recently I created some FAQs that we hope possible newcomers will find helpful and encouraging to come to church. Polish people are more and more fed up with the Catholic Church and some of them are searching for some alternatives. We want to be sure that when they enter our website they will be encouraged and not afraid to visit our service!
