Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, February 8, 2018 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, February 8, 2018 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Pastor Tim Cash from The Cross Church gave the invocation and Eagle Scout Harrison Brown led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- a. Last Month's Minutes
- b. Last Month's Financial Report
- c. Authorization to Negotiate Bond – Option C
- d. Purchase of (4) Ford F-150 Utility Trucks - \$24,736.16 each
- e. Change out/install 2 water source heat pumps – A/C Services \$9,500
- f. 2017 Gwinnett County SPLOST – Parks & Recreation
- g. Probation Contract – Southeast Corrections

Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Martinez swore in Dan Curry as a member of the Loganville Development Authority to serve out the term recently vacated by Henry Baldwin.


Civil Air Patrol Cadet Curtis Batchelor was recognized for obtaining the rank of Flight Commander by Council Member Danny Ford.

Training for elected officials was discussed by the Council. The current policy only allows for the required newly elected officials training to be paid for by the City. The proposed policy would allow for each council member to be allocated \$1,000 for training classes and \$500 for travel expenses per fiscal year. Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the proposed policy as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-2 with Council Members Jay Boland and Anne Huntsinger voting in opposition.


