Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, March 9, 2017 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, March 9, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Mark Kiddoo were all present. Council Member Rey Martinez was unable to attend.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Pastor Cortt Chavis with Truth Chapel gave the invocation and Civil Air Patrol Cadet Curtis Batchelor led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to move the traffic calming device ordinance from the consent agenda to the City Manager and adopt the agenda with this correction. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


Planning & Zoning Case V17-002 was presented to the Council by Planning Director Tim Prater. He explained that Stone Mountain Atl Hwy, LLC has filed an application requesting a variance on approximately 2.871+/- acres to reduce the side yard setback on property located at 4200 Atlanta Highway, Map/Parcel #5160-192, Gwinnett County, GA. This case was referred back to the Planning Commission in February. The Planning Commission made the recommendation to deny the request. Mohinder Singh was present representing the applicant. He explained to the Council that they are working on a compromise with Dunkin Doughnuts regarding the placement of the property line and did not think the variance would be necessary. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to deny the request based on this information. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the recommendation of City Manager Danny Roberts to reappoint Cruiser Mitchell, LLC (Robyn Webb) as City Attorney and Keck & Wood (Sam Serio) as City Engineer. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the Traffic Calming Ordinance as presented by City Attorney Robyn Webb. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
