The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Mark Kiddoo and Rey Martinez were all present.

Mayor Curry called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Rev. Mapp, Morning Star Baptist Church gave the invocation and Adam Tobler, Boy Scout Troop #582 led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve last month's minutes. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve last month's financial report as presented. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

The American Legion Riders made presentations to the Mayor and members of the Police Department for their support of the Annual Ride for America.

City Manager Danny Roberts announced that he has appointed Carl Morrow as the new Fire Chief of the Loganville Fire Department. He presented Chief Morrow with his badge and bugles, which were pinned on him by his wife Melody and daughters Tess and Reese.


Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to give the Mayor the authority to sign the ordinance amendment to the Storm Water Ordinance as mandated by the State once it is prepared by the City Attorney. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to allow the Mayor the authority to execute the revisions to the Disorderly Conduct Ordinance once it is prepared by the City Attorney. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


City Attorney Robyn Webb recommended to the Council that Ms. Pam Allen be contracted to perform a review of court functions. She expressed that this was not to imply that there is anything wrong with our court but to insure that due to recent changes in the law our court is operating at its best. She explained that to her knowledge the City has never taken an opportunity to review the court system and felt that this would be very beneficial to the City. Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve this contract with Ms. Allen for \$3,500 plus expenses not to exceed \$1,000. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

With no further business, Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
