Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, August 10, 2017 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, August 10, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Mark Kiddoo and Rey Martinez were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Dr. Hob Hoffman gave the invocation and Cadet Curtis Batchelor led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- a. Last Month's Minutes
- b. Last Month's Financial Report
- c. State of Georgia Drinking Water Lab Contract - \$10,640.00
- d. Missions Communications SCADA Contract - \$10,339.80
- e. Waterline Relocation contingent on written contract with property owner regarding cost reimbursement to City - \$15,478.78
(estimate does not include rock or replacement of asphalt)

Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Dan Curry recognized the 2017 Loganville High School Baseball team for winning the State Championship with a proclamation.

Mayor Dan Curry and Vice Mayor Mark Kiddoo recognized Curtis Dean Batchelor with a proclamation for receiving the esteemed Mitchell Award for the Civil Air Patrol.

Council Member Rey Martinez announced that he would be resigning his seat on the Council to run for Mayor.

Randy Meacham with the Gwinnett Municipal Association was present and thanked the Mayor and Council for their participation and support of the Gwinnett Municipal Association.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to set the 2017 Mileage Rate at 10.83 mills. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the relocation of the Walton County Health Department to the old City Hall location at 4385 Pecan Street contingent on the execution of a contract between the City and the Health Department approved by City Attorney Robyn Webb. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

City Manager Danny Roberts gave an update on the road work on Lee Byrd Road explained that due to the contractors hitting rock and the gas line being 3 feet under ground rather than 8 according to the locates the project is having to be redesigned to bring the road up 3 feet. He explained that the project should be complete and the roadway back open the first of September.

Election Superintendent Kristi Ash gave the Notice of General Election.

With no further business, Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
