Called Council Meeting
Thursday, August 24, 2017 10:00am
Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for a Called Council Meeting on Thursday, August 24, 2017 at 10:00am in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Mark Kiddoo were all present.


Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 10:02am.

City Manager Danny Roberts explained to that the project at Lee Byrd Road has had to be redesigned due to the contractor hitting rock. He explained that gas line was not 8ft below the ground as reported by Lawrenceville Gas but actually on top of the rock. He stated that the cost to reengineer the project at the most will cost \$56,518.68. He further explained that capital improvement money can be used for this project so the funding would not have to come from the reserves. Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the change order for the project not to exceed \$56,518.68. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

City Manager Danny Roberts stated that one of the A/C units at the old City Hall is broken and needs to be replaced. He explained that it is an old R22 unit and is outdated and leaking. The estimated cost to replace this unit is \$35,946.00. This is not a budgeted item and would need to come from reserves. There was discussion of the other three units in this building and the cost to replace them all while the building is unoccupied. Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to table this matter and allow City Manager Danny Roberts the authority to research the cost to replace all the units and bring back to the Council at that time. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
