

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, September 14, 2017 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, September 14, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Mark Kiddoo were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:31pm.

Rev. Jessica Lenox with C3 Church on 78 gave the invocation and the Civil Air Patrol led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve last month's minutes as presented. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve last month's financial report as presented. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Dan Curry presented Javan Korpi from the Civil Air Patrol with the Billy Mitchell Award and Council Member Danny Ford read a proclamation in his honor.

The Mayor and Council were presented with a proposal for the annual contract to serve the HVAC System at City Hall from Comfort Systems USA for \$6,925.11. Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the annual contract for \$6,925.11. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

City Manager Danny Roberts explained to the Mayor and Council about a drainage problem located at 213 Missionary Ridge in the Pines at Tara. He explained that the drainage at this location would need to be connected to the City's drainage system at a cost of \$7,775. Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve this project for \$7,775 to connect to the City's drainage. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


City Manager Danny Roberts explained to the Council that the roof at City Hall would have to have repair work done. He stated that there are several leaks and issues we are aware of with the roof. There have been several roofers that have taken a look at the roof and quotes / estimates for the repairs have varied from

contractor to contractor. Mr. Roberts proposed hiring a professional consultant to inspect the roof and determine a plan for these repairs in order to properly bid out the repairs. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the proposal for Roof Consulting Services from Ram USA for \$8,225. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


City Manager Danny Roberts explained that one of our patrol cars was totaled after being hit by a drunk driver and needs to be replaced. He stated that insurance will pay for the majority of the replacement. He further explained that there are no longer any 2017 Chargers available and the 2018 pricing is not available at this time. He requested the authority to purchase a replacement for a cost not to exceed \$36,000, which takes into account an increase for the 2018 model. Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the purchase of this vehicle not to exceed \$36,000. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
