

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Thursday, November 9, 2017 6:30pm Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Mark Kiddoo were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Rev. Calvin Mapp with Morning Star Baptist Church gave the invocation and the American Legion Riders led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- a. Last Month's Minutes
- b. Last Month's Financial Report
- c. See Click Fix Annual Renewal - \$5,200
- d. Harris Annual Support Contract – \$53,987.73
- e. GMA/GIRMA Firefighter's Cancer Benefits Program - \$6,148
- f. Site Med Contract - \$10,600
- g. AC Units at 4385 Pecan Street – Trust Heating and Air - \$51,250
- h. Walton County SPLOST – Parking Lot Paving \$95,000 (not to exceed)

Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Curry recognized Poppy Day and Veterans Day with proclamations.

Trinity Prep School requested approval for reduction in capital recovery fees, building permit fees and exemption for 2 years on their occupational license under Tier II due to meeting the provisions of the City's Economic Incentive Plan. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve a 30-day moratorium on the Economic Incentive Plan and the Small Business Plan for Main Street to allow City Attorney Robyn Webb to review the plans. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the Reuse Water Rates / Tap Fees as presented. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to give City Manager Danny Roberts the approval of an amount not to exceed \$60,000 to negotiate and plan the concert series for 2018. He also

noted that this amount is budgeted and funded through sponsorships, donations and rental fees. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
