

## **MINUTES**

### **CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Thursday, October 12, 2017 6:30pm Council Chambers**

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, October 12, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Mark Kiddoo were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:31pm.

Dr. Henry Baldwin from Holy Cross Anglican Church gave the invocation and Council Member Mark Kiddoo led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- a. Last Month's Minutes
- b. Last Month's Financial Report
- c. Door Access System – Police Department - \$10,471.55 (forfeited funds)

Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Dan Curry recognized October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month, Breast Cancer Awareness Month and Fire Prevention Month.

Planning & Zoning Case #R17-007 was presented to the Council. Applicant Thomas Carter has requested that .71 acres located at 108 Main Street be rezoned from R16 to CH for the use as an insurance office. There was no opposition to this case. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the rezoning request as approve with the condition that all parking spaces be aligned on the south side of the property. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the Reuse Utilities Expansion allowing for the installation of 3000ft of 10" purple PVC reuse water main to provide reuse water service to future sites, installation of a .5 mgd storage tank and pumping system at an estimated cost of \$1,082,400. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the repair to the Towler Shoals / Chandler Walk Sewer Line for a cost of \$16,600 due to recent storm damage. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the 2018 Supplemental LMIG Project List for the maintenance and resurfacing of .654 miles of city streets (Fox Briar Court, Fox Run and Red Fox Trail) for a total cost of \$166,608.87 of which the City is responsible for \$38,448.20. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the 2017 Gwinnett SPLOST Inter-governmental Agreement for the installation of sidewalks from Old Loganville Road to Tuck Road. The total cost of the project is \$486,640 with a total contribution from SPLOST funds of \$394,178. The City will be responsible for the remaining balance to complete the project (\$92,462). Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

City Manager Danny Roberts explained for the record that the Council had previously approved a Walton County for paving at a cost of \$180,000. He further explained that the scope of the project has changed and it will now be used to pave the parking lot at City Hall at a reduced cost of \$82,500.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the recommendation of City Manager Danny Roberts to place additional signage at Ivy Ridge Subdivision to help with traffic control. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
