

## MINUTES

Regular Council Meeting  
Thursday, December 14, 2017 6:30pm  
Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, December 14, 2017 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Mark Kiddoo were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Pastor Brent Ross from Hope Community Fellowship gave the invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of a housekeeping item under the finance committee reports. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion with the addition. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Walton County Chamber of Commerce President Teri Smiley presented the Annual Contract to the Mayor and Council. Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the contract as presented. Council Member Danny Form seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Dan Curry gave the Oath of Office to Chris Hulan. Mr. Hulan was appointed to the LDA by Council Member Danny Ford to replace Henry Baldwin.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to accept the revised Economic Incentive Policy as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the revised Small Business Incentive Policy for Main Street. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


