The City of Loganville Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for a Called Council Meeting on Thursday, June 7, 2018 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were present. Council Member Jay Boland was unable to attend.


Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:31pm.

Finance Committee Chair Anne Huntsinger explained that the City has been working on the 2018 Bond issue for several month and ask Andrew Tritt with Merchant Capital and Jim Monacell with Smith, Gambrell and Russell to update the Council on the matter. Mr. Tritt presented the financing bond was sold today on the market. He explained that the City has a Double A3 rating which allowed the bond to yield 3.04% interest rate for 20 years. He explained that this bond included the restructure of the 2012 Bond Issue and will fund a 14-million-dollar expansion project to the City treatment facility. Mr. Monacell explained that this bond ordinance that they are requesting the City Council approve will replace the 2012 Bond Ordinance. Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to enact the Bond Ordinance as presented. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

City Manager Danny Roberts presented the 2019-2021 CDBG Cooperation Agreement with Gwinnett County to the Council. He explained that in order to participate in the program every three years we are required to adopt the cooperation agreement. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the Cooperation Agreement with Gwinnett County as presented. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
