

**MINUTES**

**Regular Council Meeting**  
**Thursday, March 14, 2019 6:30pm**  
**Council Chambers**

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, March 14, 2019 at 6:30pm. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:32pm.

Pastor Jonas Chambliss with Living Word Baptist Church and Pastor Russ Butcher with The Church at the Grove gave invocations.

Council Member Jay Boland led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to adopt the agenda. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda as follows:

Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

April McClendon, area representative with FCA gave a presentation to the audience regarding FCA.

Ms. Gisane Vincent presented Life Save Awards to the following Police, Fire and EMS personnel who responded to her residence and were instrumental in saving her life due to a recent cardiac event. Those recognized were as follows: LFD Capt. Andy Logan, Sgt. 
Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the requested Economic Incentive Package Tier I for Rector Lofton, P.C. totaling \$4,536.79. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

City Manager Danny Roberts and City Attorney Robyn Webb spoke about the review of the court appointed professional staff. She explained that she would like to request that the council allow Court Clerk Kim Pickens along with herself and the judge take a look at the position of judge and solicitor. She further explained that she felt like as an extension of the recent review of court procedures the salary of these two positions be studied to make sure the positions are being adequately compensated, a term for the judge be considered as well as take a look at the code to see if any amendments are necessary to improve the functionality of the court system. She requested that this take place over the next 60 days. Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the review as requested by the City Attorney. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the resolution for the 2020 CDBG for storm drainage and paving on the east side of Pecan Street for \$487,499.00 (30% city match). Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

With no further business, Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
