

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Thursday, May 9, 2019 6:30pm Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, May 9, 2019 at 6:30pm. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:31pm.

Pastor Jonas Chambliss of Living Word Baptist Church gave the invocation and Timothy Simmons, Boy Scout Troop #536 led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Planning & Development Case #R19-003 was presented to the Council by Planning Director Tim Prater. Mr. Prater explained that The Bredas, LLC c/o Mahaffey Pickens Tucker, LLP has requested that 17.411 acres located at 112 Brand Road be rezoned from R44 to CH to allow for an office and training location for a pest control company. There was no one present to offer public comment in favor or opposition to this case. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the rezoning of this property from R44 to CH with the following conditions:

1. Any new parking areas constructed on the property shall be screened from view of Brand Road with landscaping and/or fencing.

2. Installation of six (6) additional evergreen or other landscape screening in the rear year of the existing main structure along the property line bordering the Laurel Mist subdivision.


Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-1 with Council Member Danny Ford abstaining due to conflict.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the purchase of a replacement chipper for a price not to exceed \$54,250.00. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


