

## MINUTES

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, August 8, 2019 at 6:30pm. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Skip Baliles, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford and Anne Huntsinger were all present. Council Member Lisa Newberry was unable to attend.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Director of Utilities Chris Yancey gave the invocation and Council Member Danny Ford led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

She explained that the 2017 Millage Rate was 12.32, however due to growth it is recommended to accept the roll back rate of 11.85. Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to set the 2019 Millage Rate at 11.85. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the 2019 SRO Contract with Walton County Board of Education. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the proposed Scooter Ordinance to outlaw scooters in the City. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the extension of the 2018 CDBG to expend the funds. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business to discuss, Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to adjourn and enter into Executive Session to discuss legal matters with Counsel. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


