Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, October 10, 2019 6:30pm

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 6:30pm. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

The Invocation was given and the pledge to the flag led.

Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of adding the Walton County Chamber of Commerce Annual Contract to the agenda. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Mrs. Smiley presented the Annual Contract to the Council. Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the contract as presented. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to amend the police department vehicle line item to include insurance proceeds to \$105,616.89. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.




