

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, November 14, 2019 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, November 14, 2019 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:34pm.

Mark Mirza with Common Thread Ministries gave the invocation, the National Anthem was sung and the pledge was led by Mitchell Matthews.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Rey Martinez presented the Annual Poppy Day Proclamation and the recognition that Loganville has been named a Purple Heart City.

Police Chief Mike McHugh and the Police Department presented a check to Walton County Special Olympics from the proceeds of the Annual Donut Dash.

Planning & Development Director Tim Prater presented an Amendment to Chapter 119 of the City Code of Ordinances replacing Article IV Division 3 Section 249. The primary changes to this section relate to minimum lot size and units per acre. Jeff Henson, 3842 Jacks Creek Road, Monroe GA spoke in opposition in regards to his proposed development that this amendment would impact. With no other opposition, Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the amendment as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Planning & Development Director Tim Prater presented Case #R19-012 to the Council. He explained that Thomas W. Carter has requested to rezone 1.978 acres located at 4280 Lawrenceville Road from R44 to CH to be used as office space. There was no opposition or comment regarding this case. Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve Case #R19-02. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the annual CodeRed invoice for \$8,152. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the October financial report. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the 2019 Water & Sewer Specifications as presented. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the Fire Station Signal Pre-Emption for Station 18 on Old Loganville Road not to exceed \$125,000 to be paid for from Gwinnett County SPLOST. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the purchase of a 2020 Ford F-150 Utility Truck for \$31,929. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Andrew Tritt presented the \$4.5M supplemental bond to the Council. He explained that his is a 9 year private placement at 1.81% interest. The purpose is to fund the additional water access point and Monroe Waterline project. Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the supplemental bond ordinance. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Rey Martinez recognized the recent passing Maya Matthews and her family.

With no further business, Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
