

MINUTES
CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, December 12, 2019 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, December 12, 2019 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Liz Robertson gave the invocation and the pledge to the flag was led.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented and Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Police Chief Mike McHugh recognized Jonathan Warren as the Officer of the Year as voted on by his peers.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- a. Last Month's Minutes
- b. Last Month's Financial Report
- c. Walton County Easement for Monroe / Loganville Water Line Meter Vault
- d. IGA – Loganville / Walton Water Intergovernmental Agreement – Claude Brewer booster station and transmission line

Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Planning & Development Case #R19-013 was presented to the Council. Robert Hardin has requested to rezone 0.91 acres of property located at 425 Conyers Road from R22 to CH for use as office space. There was no one presented to speak in favor or opposition of this case. Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the rezone as requested. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger presented the Sanitation Contract with Advanced Disposal to the Mayor and Council. She explained that this contract included a 3% increase in rates due to the increased cost in recycling and an increase to roll off containers as well. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the contract as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the GDOT Quick Response Project for HWY 81/ CS Floyd improvements not to exceed \$100,000 with Vertical Earth. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd announced that the City of Loganville has been designated an official Tree City.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to close open session and go into Executive Session to discuss Real Estate Matters. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


