The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for a Called Council Meeting on Wednesday, April 22, 2020 at 6:30pm via Zoom Conferencing due to the COVID-19 crisis. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the emergency order. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.


Mayor Rey Martinez gave the invocation and the pledge to the flag was led.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to adopt the agenda. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


City Attorney Robyn Webb explained that the purpose of this discussion was to extend the City's current Emergency Order which is scheduled to expire on April 23, 2020 at 9am. She explained that since the State's Emergency Order is set to expire on May 13th extending the order another 30 days would allow the City additional coverage for business and allow for emergency purchases that might be needed due to the current situation. There was much discussion regarding extending the order through the 13th (the same as the State) or through the 22nd. After discussion, Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to extend the emergency order as presented through May 22nd. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-1 with Council Member Anne Huntsinger voting in opposition.

With no further business, Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
