Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the agenda. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve last month's minutes. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve last month's financial report. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the addition of the following streets into the City Owned Street Inventory: Twin Lakes Road, Sonja Lane, Logan Point Drive, Loganview Drive and Horizon Trace at a total of 2.35 additional miles. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the Cown Drive Gravity Sewer Line Project at a cost not to exceed \$170,000.00 to be paid for from Capital Recovery Fees. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Bill Duvall made a motion to approve the purchase of a Task Master Titian Grinder to help make the Logan Point Pump Station operate more efficiently at a cost of \$68,312.50.00. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Bill Duvall made a motion to approve the Annual Water Tank Maintenance Contract with Utility Services for \$13,788.87 for the Pecan Street Tank. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.


Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the C.S .Floyd Road Project NTE \$100,000.00.


City Manager Danny Roberts gave an update on COVID-19.
