

**A RESOLUTION TO IMPOSE A MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE OR CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR REZONE OF MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL DENSITY DISTRICTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Loganville is committed to regulating multifamily residential density within the City in a way that allows growth of development while also recognizing the need for appropriate regulation;


**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of this commitment, the City would like to review and possibly revise the definitions of Multifamily Residential Density contained in section 119-211, 119-212, 119-213, 119-221 & 119-250 of its Zoning ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Loganville:

**RESOLVE**, that the City shall not accept or consider any applications for Multifamily Residential Density for a period of sixty (60) days or the repeal of this resolution, whichever date occurs first; and

**FURTHER RESOLVE** that the provisions of this Resolution are severable, and should any part of this Resolution be deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.
