CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, June 11, 2020 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, June 11, 2020 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Mayor Rey Martinez asked everyone to observe a moment of silence in honor of former Mayor and Council Member Mike Jones who had recently passed away.

A local Boy Scout led the pledge to the flag and the invocation was given by Brett Johnson from New Testament Baptist Church.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- Walton County School Water Line - \$12,000

Council Member Bill DuVall seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Rey Martinez gave the oath of office to newly appointed members of the LDA: Dana Russell (Lisa Newberry), Michael Dermer (Rey Martinez), Tricia Elliot (Danny Ford) and Skip Baliles (Anne Huntsinger).

Mayor Rey Martinez read a proclamation in honor of nurses and recognized several nurses from Piedmont Walton Hospital.

Planning and Zoning Case #A20-001 was presented the Council. Mark Davis had requested to annex 0.952 acres into the City of Loganville located at 315 Skyland Drive for use as office/retail space. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to deny the annexation due to the entrance to the business being in a subdivision. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-2 with Council Member Linda Dodd and Anne Huntsinger voting in opposition.

Planning and Zoning Case #R20-003 was presented to the Council. Thiep Huynh had requested to rezone 0.96 acres located on Overlook Drive from R16 to CH for an Auto Shop. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to deny the rezone request due to the proposed land use being located in a residential area. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Planning and Zoning Case #R20-004 was presented to the Council. Thiep Huynh had requested to rezone 0.55 acres located on Overlook Drive from R16 to CH for an Auto Shop. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to deny the rezone request due to the proposed land use being located in a residential area. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

David Kirk has filed an appeal on behalf of Walmart to the denial of a sign permit for their building. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to table this matter to allow the City to study the current sign ordinance and determine if there needs to be an amendment in regard to signs for buildings of this size. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to approve a 60 Day Moratorium on Multifamily Residential Density Districts. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made motion to approve the renewal of the City Property and Liability Insurance for a cost not to exceed \$230,000. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


