

**MINUTES

**Regular Council Meeting  
Thursday, November 12, 2020 6:30pm  
Council Chambers**

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, November 12, 2020 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Pastor Dustin Wilbanks from The Cross Loganville gave the invocation and American Legion Post 233 Color Guard led the pledge.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to amend the agenda to include an easement and a report on Veteran's Day. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to adopt the agenda. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Mayor Rey Martinez made a presentation to Gwinnett County Chairwoman Charlotte Nash in recognition of her service the Gwinnett County and the City of Loganville. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to amend Division 2, Article II of Chapter 119 of The Code of Ordinances of the City of Loganville entitled Planning Commission clarifying

the establishment of the planning commission. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to amend Subpart B, Land Development and Related Ordinances, Chapter 119, Zoning Code to define and limit Section 141 (6) RM-8 Zoning as presented. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the costs of the Citizens Advisory Group survey regarding future development at a cost not to exceed \$11,887.50. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-1 with Council Member Jay Boland voting in opposition.

Council Member Jay Boland recognized David and Toby Sparks for organizing the Back the Blue Car Show and their donation to the Police Department for \$11,000.00.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the IGA with Gwinnett County regarding Route 16. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.




